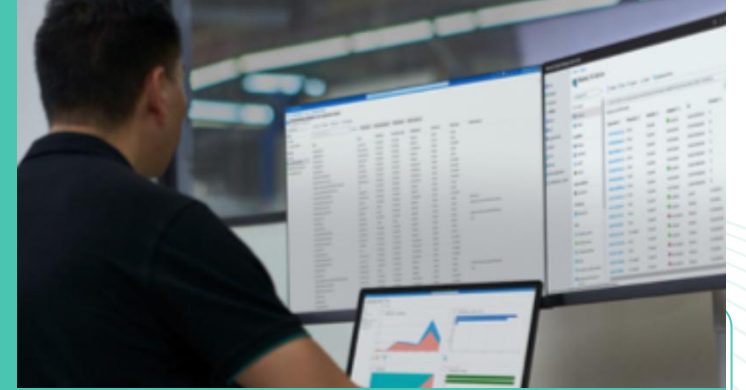

Microsoft 365 Copilot 15% Nonprofit Discount SKU

On November 1, 2024, Microsoft announced a nonprofit-specific discount on Microsoft 365 Copilot, available to CSP partners globally. There is no minimum purchase requirement, and no limit on the number of licenses you can buy.

UPDATE: As of January 1st, your customers can now be eligible for flexible billing options.

Enjoy better cash flow with an annual commitment and monthly payments, available at 5% higher than the annual upfront payment option.

What is the nonprofit Microsoft 365 Copilot discounted SKU?

Microsoft is providing a 15% discount off the Partner Unit Price for Microsoft 365 Copilot, for eligible nonprofit customers that already have a qualifying subscription.

Who is eligible for this nonprofit Microsoft 365 Copilot discounted SKU?

This discounted nonprofit SKU is available to eligible nonprofit customers who have a qualifying subscription, globally. This offer is available only for new subscription purchases – it cannot be applied to add seats to existing subscriptions.

What organizations should Partners target with this offer?

The target audience for this offer is eligible nonprofit customers who already have an eligible Microsoft 365 pre-requisite license. Messaging is aimed at AI BDMs, department leaders, and IT roles ready to start their AI journey.

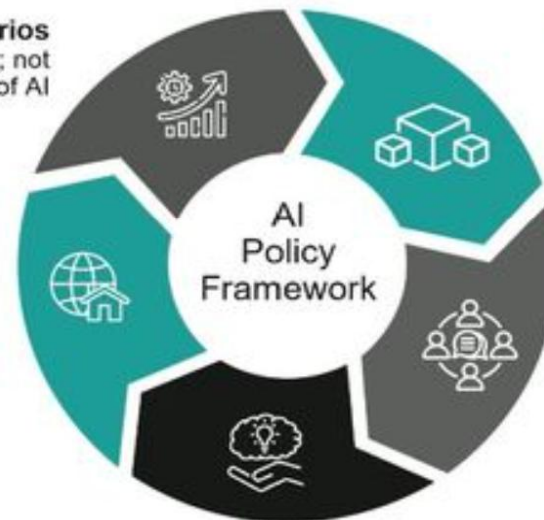

Dear Partners,

Thank you for your continued partnership with Microsoft and Tech for Social Impact. As part of our commitment to bring more value to nonprofit organizations and our partner community, Microsoft would like to bring you guidance about the **Yearly Giving Calculation** that the **Fundraising and Engagement application** provides.

The purpose of the Yearly Giving Calculation is to recalculate the yearly giving totals of every Contact and Account in the Azure SQL database. However, due to synchronization limitations, there might be issues with calculating and synchronizing the data from Azure SQL to Dataverse. Use this guidance on the Yearly Giving Calculation to optimize and overcome any limitations.
