Professional Award Criteria

- Awards will recognize a person, company or government entity for waste reduction or recycling initiatives under-taken in calendar year 2024.
- An individual/program does not need to be an AROW member, but they must be nominated by an AROW member to qualify for an award.

Award	Description	Criteria
Christy Dixon Recycler of the Year	An individual whose career demonstrates the highest professional standards in the recycling field (includes reuse and composting).	 Applicant may be from the public, private, or nonprofit sector. If a person has already received this award, they are not eligible to receive the award a second time.
Outstanding Achievement in Education	An individual or group that has excelled in environmental education, specifically related to solid waste and recycling.	 Applicant may be from the public, private, or nonprofit sector.
Outstanding Achievement in Waste Reduction & Recycling	An individual or group that has excelled with waste reduction and recycling within their program.	 Applicant may be from the public, private, or nonprofit sector.
Outstanding Achievement in Waste Reduction & Recycling – Professional Athlete	A professional athlete or team that has excelled with waste reduction and recycling within their program or "on the field."	 A professional athlete or team.

Student Award

Student Award Criteria

- Award will recognize a student of higher education. Graduates must be nominated within one year of graduation date.
- Activities must have occurred during current academic career. Current academic career refers to the active consecutive years in higher education. Examples: 1) If you are a senior and you worked on a project during the summer after your sophomore year, this would be eligible. 2) If you did a project in your junior year and then took a few years off of school and then returned and are completing your degree this is now your current academic career and that project would not be eligible.

Outstanding Achievement in Waste Reduction and Recycling – Student	An individual that has excelled with their overall activities, or a specific project, supporting waste reduction, sustainability, recycling, and/or organics management.	 Applicant must be a student of higher education or recent graduate.
Certificate of Recognition for Outstanding Achievement in Waste Reduction and Recycling – Youth Emerging Leader	A youth that has excelled with their overall activities, or a specific project, supporting	 Award will recognize a K-12 student. Activities must have occurred within the last 18 months. Student Teacher/Advisor(s) to the project must be listed Nominator does not have to be an
