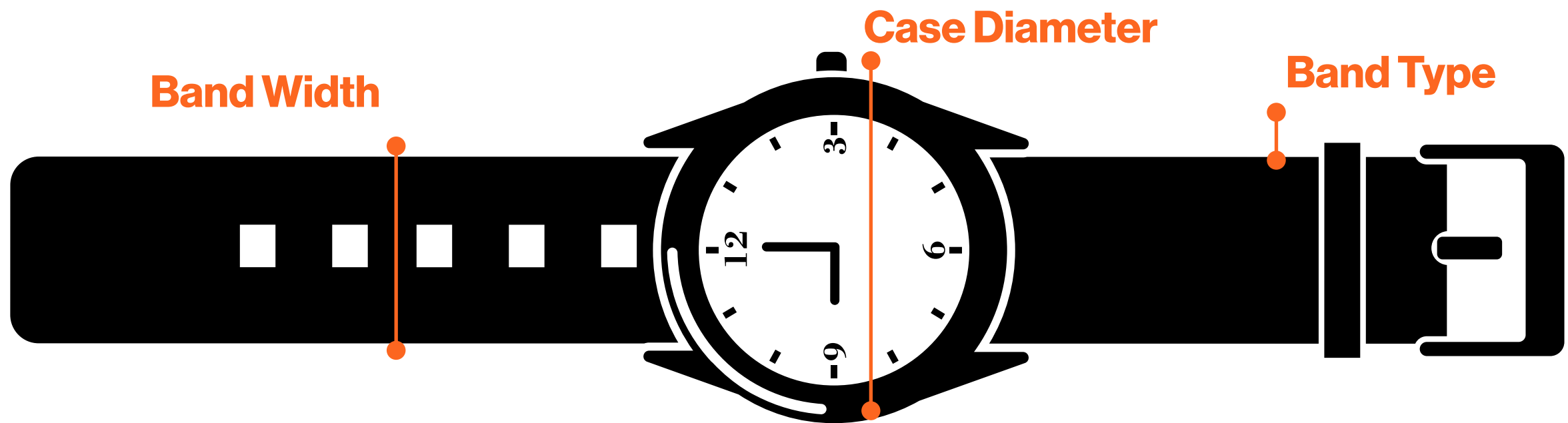


## Watches Specification



### Case Diameter

Measure your wrist. If it is thinner than 12-13 cm, you may choose watches in the 38-42 mm range. If it is thicker than 18 cm, you may choose watches in the 44-50 mm range.

### Case Thickness

Watches with more thickness have a dynamic appearance. Classic models are designed to be thinner and more elegant.

### Band Width

To find out the appropriate band width for your watch, you can measure the space between the inside of the lugs where the band will be attached.

### Band Type

Wicker or fabric bands offer a more dynamic appearance while leather straps provide a more formal appearance.
