Age requirements: Minimum 16 years on completion to be eligible to receive your certification.

Course fee: \$675.00

Important to note:

- Level 2 Coach Certification consists of two parts: Practical Course (4-day course) and Online Courses in the SqA LC [here](#).
- The certification fee covers the Level 2 Coach Certification (both the Practical and Online modules) but is not inclusive of the WSF SPIN fee to WSF.
- Before attending the Practical Course, Learners need to register and pay for their Certification [here](#).
- Learners need to endeavour to complete all the online modules before the practical course.
- Registrations to the practical course are open on the Squash Australia website [here](#), choose the course and click 'Details'.

- Learners will receive their 'Completion Certificate' once they have completed all components (practical and online) and have been assessed as competent in their post-course tasks.
- Level 2 Coaching Certificate is only valid if accompanied by a valid WSF SPIN and Working with Children Check.

Step-by-Step Guide for Learners:

ONLINE LEARNING:

1. Register your account in the Squash Australia Learning Centre (SqA LC) - <https://learning.squash.org.au/login/index.php>
2. Select '**Coaching**' and then [Level 2 Coaching Certification](#).
3. Pay the Squash Australia certification fee of \$675.00: Click 'Add to shopping cart' and then go to the shopping cart  on the top right-hand side of the page and finalise the payment.
4. Complete the '**Level 2 Coach Enrolment Questions**' which opens all the other courses in the Certification.
5. Register your Sport Integrity Australia (SIA) account here: <https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au/login/index.php> and complete the integrity courses listed below. (Click on the course name below to open).

Once completed, upload and submit the SIA eLearning Certificate (not badges) to the SqA LC.

This activity will show as incomplete until a Squash Australia Admin verifies your certificate.

6. Confirm that you have completed the '**World Squash Officiating Level 0**' by uploading and submitting your 'Level 0 – Rules' completion Certificate. You can access the course here: <https://worldsquashofficiating.com/courses/wso-level-0-rules/>.

This activity will show as incomplete until a Squash Australia Admin verifies your certificate.

7. Finalise all other administrative tasks:

- Register and pay for World Squash Federation SPIN membership (GBP £15.00) (<https://wsf.tournamentsoftware.com/memberships>) and copy that SPIN to the '**WSC SPIN Membership**' course so Squash Australia staff can validate this for you.
- Upload your valid First Aid and CPR Certificate (HLTAID011 includes a Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certificate). Please note that the First Aid Certificate is valid for three (3) years and the CPR Certificate is valid for 12 months.
- Agree to a waiver for '**SqA Protective Eyewear Indemnity**' and '**Code of Behaviour (Coaches)**'.
- Upload and submit a current **Working with Children Check** for assessment. Learners under 18 who have not completed their WWCC can upload a copy of their proof of age document (e.g. student ID).

PRACTICAL COURSE:

8. Register for the Squash Australia Practical Course through the Education Calendar on the SqA website [HERE](#).
- Choose your preferred location and date,
 - Click 'Details' and then 'Register'.
 - Please note that you don't need to register for the practical course in the SqA LC. Squash Australia staff will do that for you once you have registered via the Education Calendar.

COMPLETION:

Once you have completed all the online courses and your practical learning and the post-course assessment (4 lesson plans) have been deemed competent, you can download your certificate from the last course on the certification '**Level 2 Coach Certificate**' by clicking 'Launch course'.
