Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have insurance cover at an unaffiliated venue?

Not covered, unless this activity is sanctioned via Squash Australia / Squash Australia Member Organisations e.g., running participation program at a school that is approved by Squash Australia.

Do I have insurance cover if I have been invited to demonstrate squash at a local park along with other sports by the local council or a community group?

Not covered, unless this activity is sanctioned via Squash Australia / Squash Australia Member Organisation.

Do I have insurance cover if am running a camp of international players, referees at an affiliated venue?

Covered because the venue is affiliated with Squash Australia / Squash Australia Member Organisation.

Do I have insurance cover if I am working with players / referees on a freelance basis? Not covered by Squash Australia insurance.

Do I have insurance if I run coaching sessions at a private house?

Not covered, unless this activity is sanctioned via Squash Australia / Squash Australia Member Organisation.

If a coach has their own coaching business?

Not covered, coaches are required to provide their own insurance.

If a coach is employed by a Recreation Centre?

The Recreation Centre provides the insurance cover.

If a coach hires & pays for the use of the courts at a Recreation Centre that is an affiliated venue?

Covered because the venue is affiliated with Squash Australia / Squash Australia Member Organisation.

If you are looking to run a coaching /referee activity check with your State Member Organisation before starting to whether this activity is approved and insured.

Please note to be registered as a Squash Australia Coach / Referee you are required to have a current certification by Squash Australia.



Clubs / Recreation Centres must be affiliated with Squash Australia to be covered under Squash Australia V-Insurance.
