


# % of initiatives using COCS vs IOCS

8 initiatives out of 11 that started used the Central Collection System


3 initiatives out of 11 that started used the Individual Collection System

## Cohesion Policy – state of play

- 21 MS have uploaded their Annex VI
- 6 MS still to upload their Annex VI (HR,CY,DK,LV,NL,PT)
- 17 Annexes VI uploaded within the 3 months period (10 Annex VI were missing on 16/10/2021)
- MS that have not yet provided/uploaded Annexes VI or in wrong format are in the process of being contacted



# File Exchange Service – Lessons learned (1/4)

The FES has been used two times since last October:

- 1. Test campaign: 02/10/2020 02/02/2021
- 2. Cohesion policy used the File Exchange Service to submit electronic statements of support on 16/07/2021

#### Lessons learned (2/4)

- The process works and all stakeholders demonstrated their capabilities to handle it.
- Less MS encryption credentials had to be renewed for Cohesion policy (4 MS) vs test campaign (10 MS).
- We should aim that 0 credentials are renewed during a transfer -> MS to inform the EC whenever there is a change of staff responsible for the FES (refer to the documentation and expert group meeting presentation 22/10/2020).
- Some new MS representatives were not aware of the process. Please inform the EC for every new contact person and share the FES documentation.



# Lessons learned (3/4)

Reach consensus on a coordinated approach on the start date of the verification process in case organisers use different channels for transmission:

- Organisers can decide to use the FES to transfer both the electronic and paper statements as well as the Annex V. Commission will then transfer all documents for all MS in one go. The three-months verification period for all MS will start as of then.
- However, organisers can also decide to submit the statements of supports for each Member State
  via different channels, e.g. by handing in paper statements physically (via mail or by hand, and on
  different dates) and electronic ones via the FES. As a result, it is not likely that a Member State
  receives all documents at the same time.
- Proposal: In such a scenario, Commission will coordinate the transfer with organisers that use
  FES, and agree that all Annex V are uploaded in the FES. Commission will submit the Annex V and
  the electronic statements of support uploaded in the FES to the Member States only after
  organisers have declared that all paper forms have been received by the Member States.
  The three-month counter starts as of then.

#### Lessons learned (4/4)

- Some Annex VI were not following the Annex VI templates of the ECI Regulation. MS are free to use their own language and to attach their own national decision to the Annex VI, however please use the right format of the Annex VI certificate
- Some Annexes VI were referring to the wrong ECI Regulation (Cohesion Policy was registered under the old Regulation and the Annexes VI should have referred to it).
- Some Member States did not upload their Annex VI on the File Exchange Service but sent it directly to the organisers. While there is no obligation to do so under the Regulation, it is a good practice to do so.



#### Conclusions and next actions on the FES

- Commission will send a short questionnaire to gather feedback on the proposed approach, based on the feedback received, it will finalise and circulate its guidance to be applied to the next cases.
- Initiative "Save bees and farmers!" informed the E.C. that they will submit to Member States. They are reflecting on using the FES (not confirmed yet). This is also an initiative that was registered under the old ECI regulation (Annex VI should refer to the old ECI regulation).
- There will be another test campaign in 2022 in case no initiative plans to use the FES to transfer its statements to all Member States within one year.
