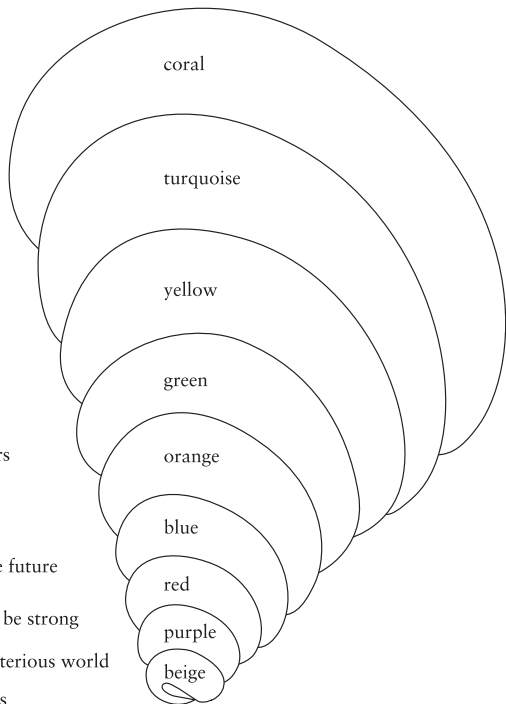
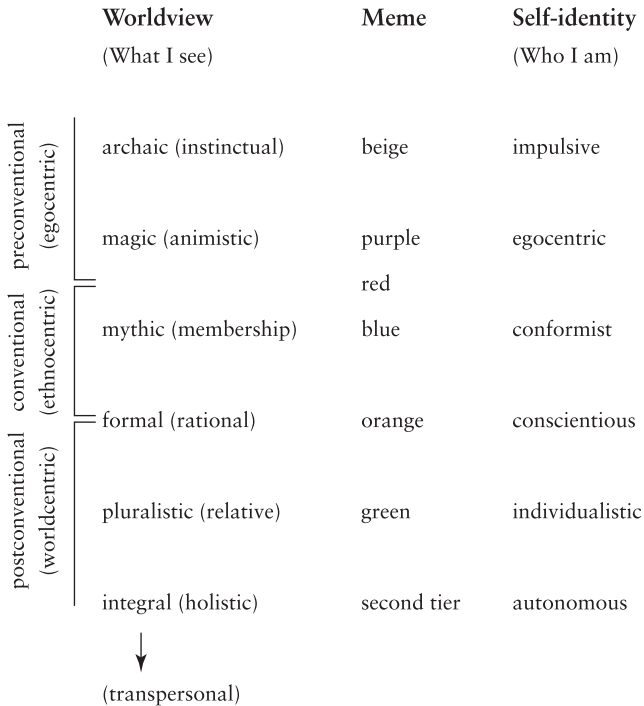

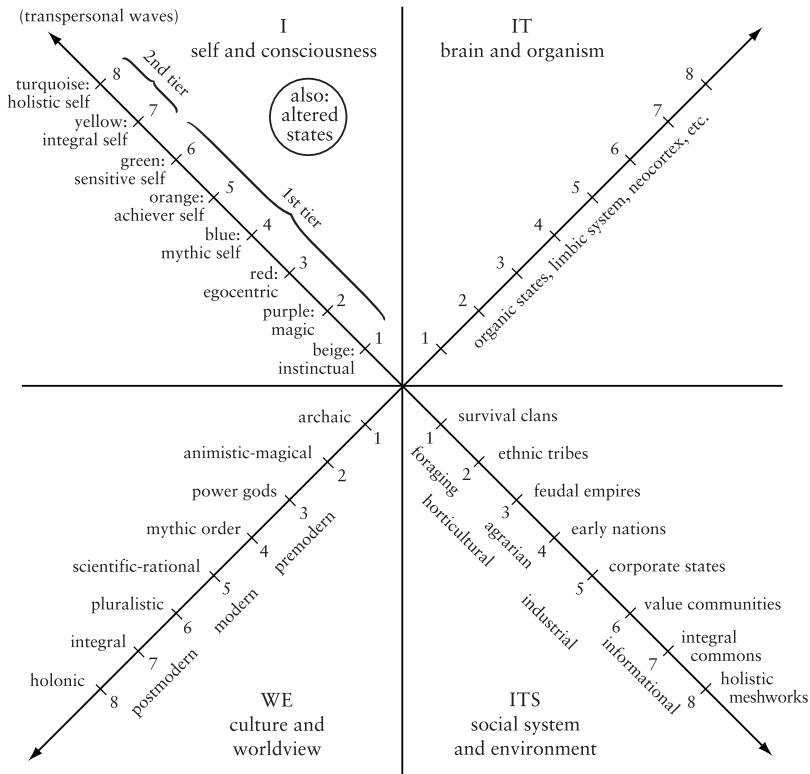
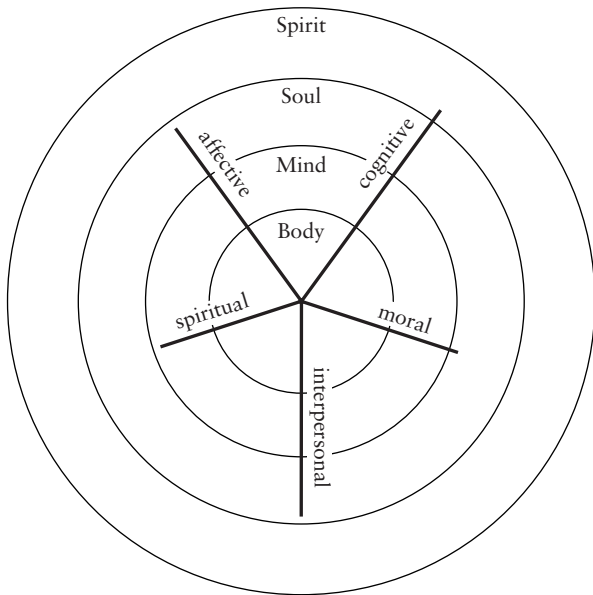


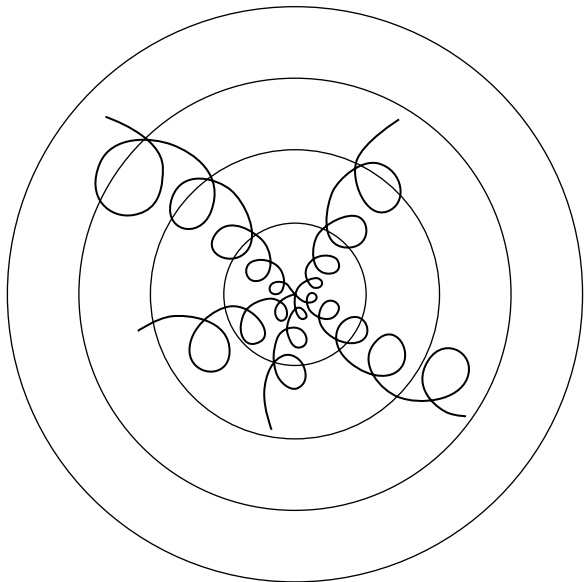
Figure 3-1. Some Examples of the Four Quadrants in Humans



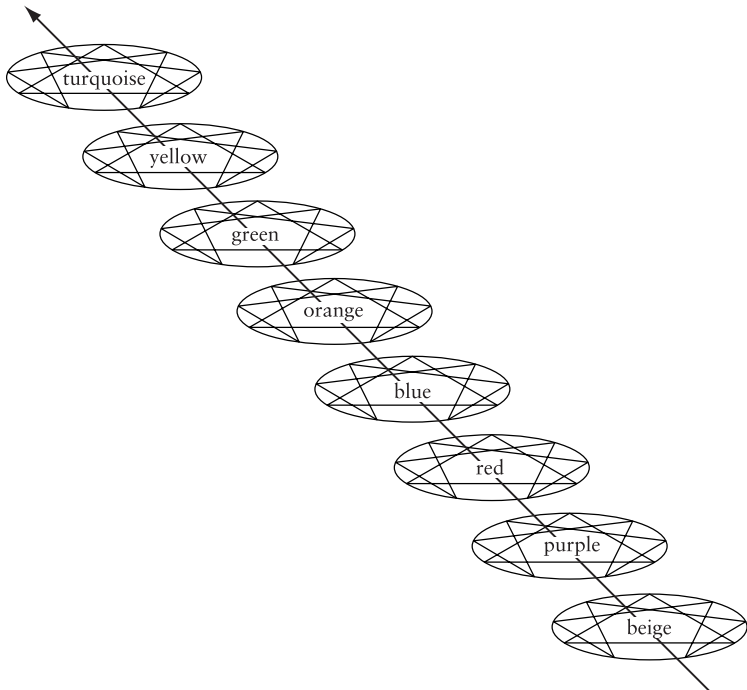
*Figure 3-2. Waves and Streams*

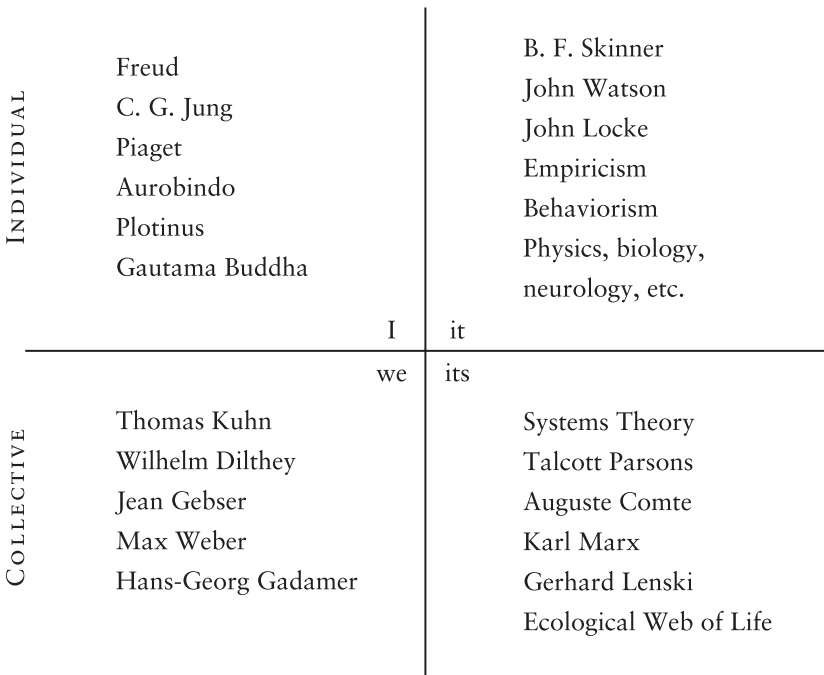
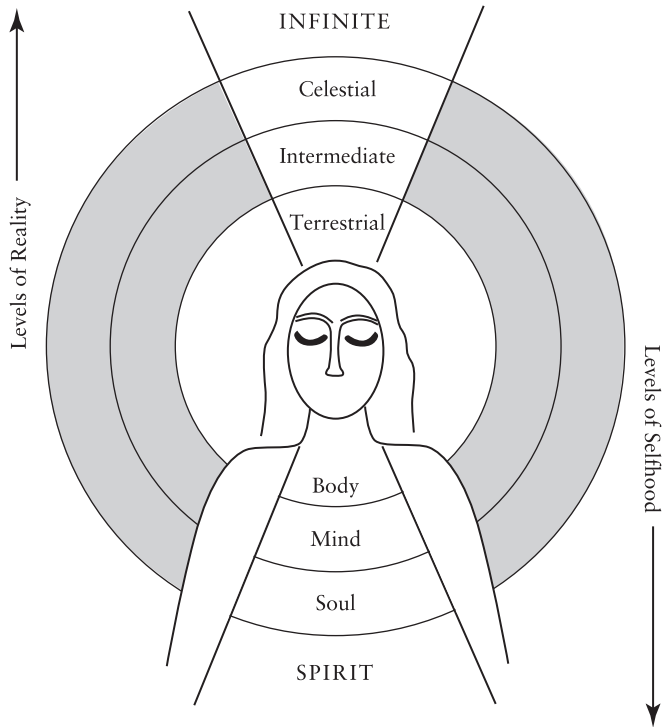


Figure 3-6. Some Representative Theorists in Each Quadrant

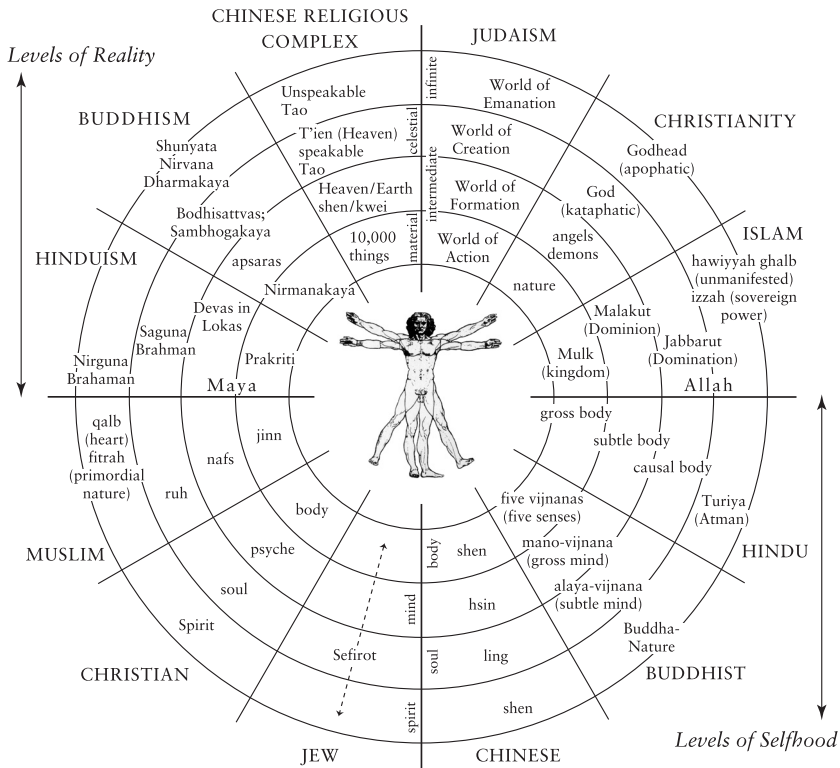
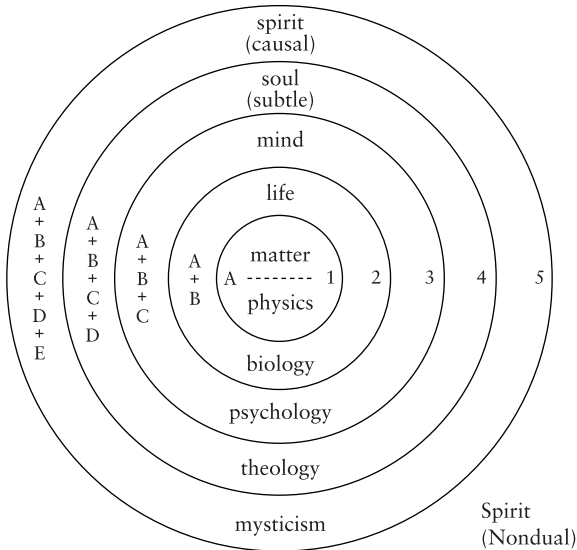


Figure 4-2. The Great Nest in Various Traditions.

*Figure 4-3. The Great Hierarchy. Spirit is both the highest level (causal) and the nondual Ground of all levels.*

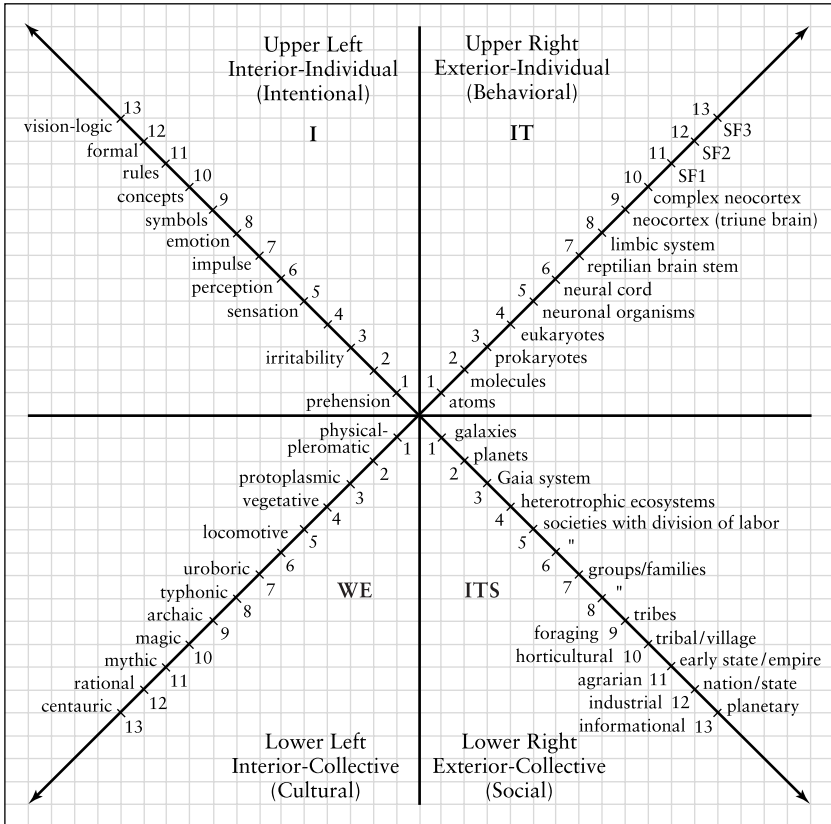
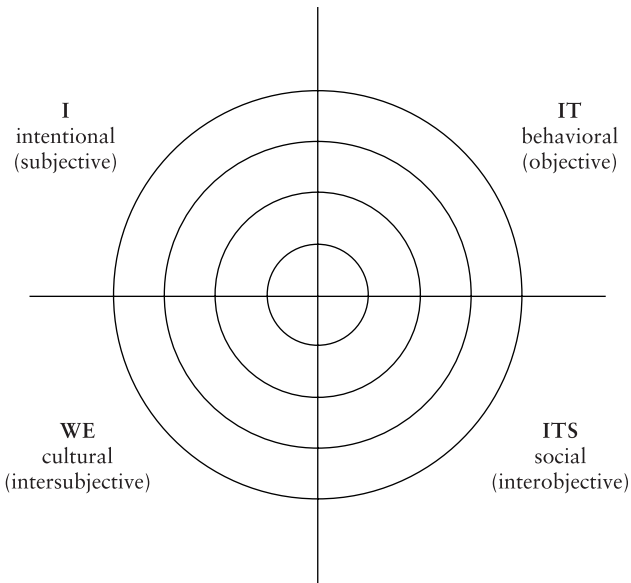
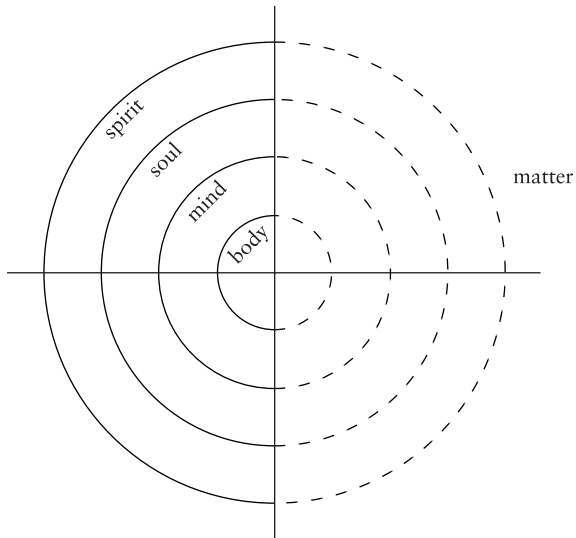


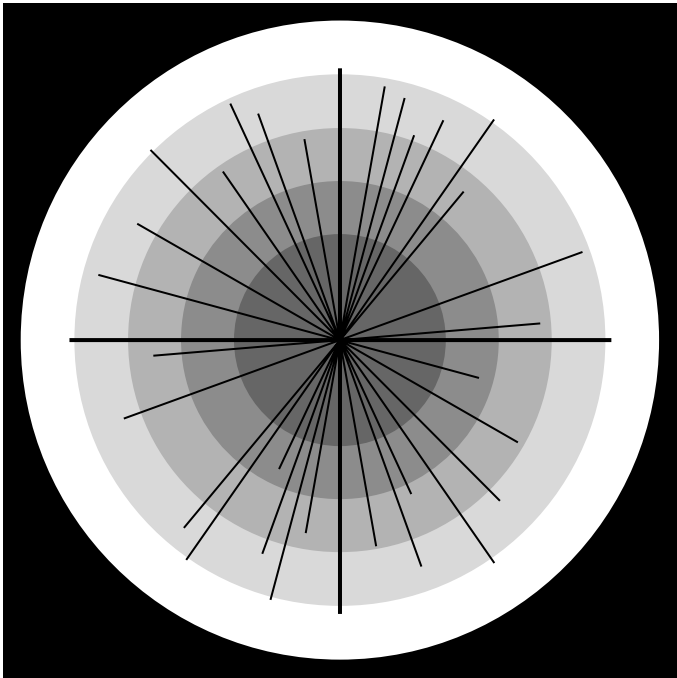
Figure 4-4. The Four Quadrants

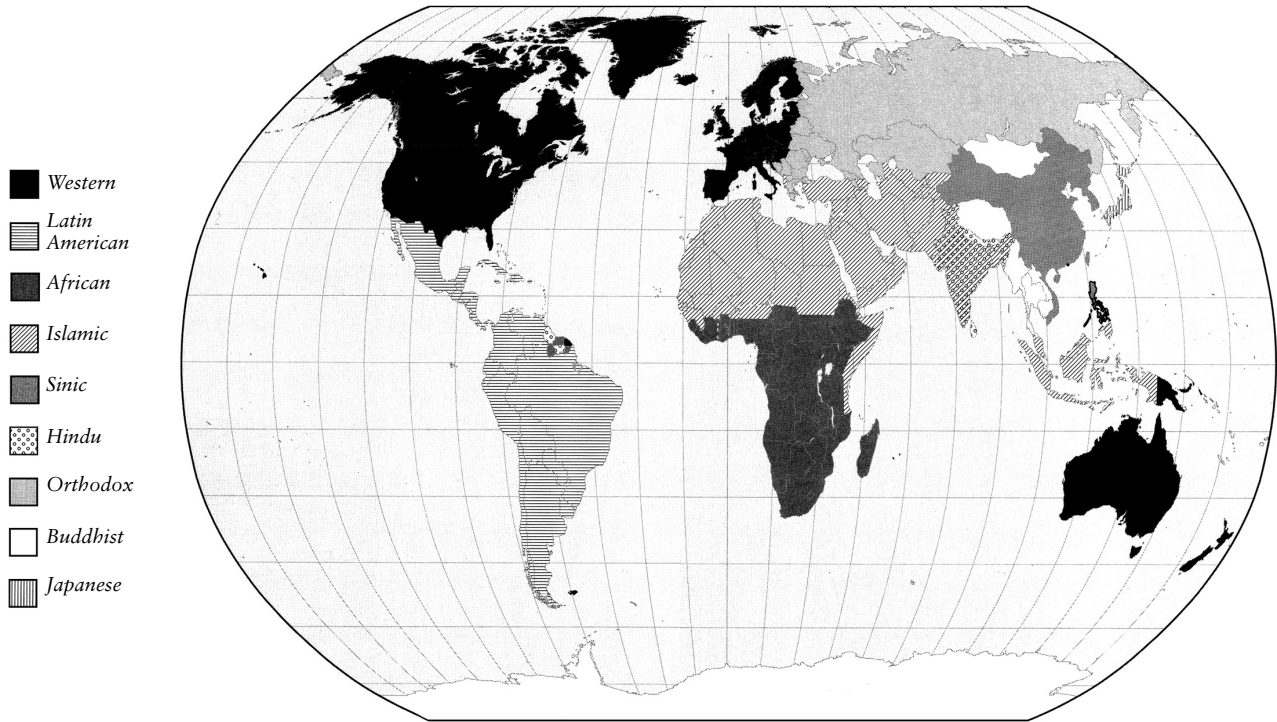
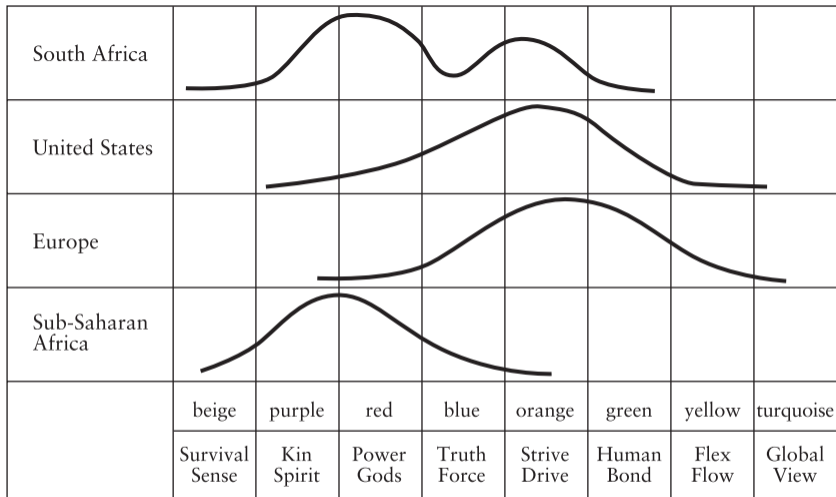


Figure 6-1. *Civilization Blocks*. Adapted, by permission, from Samuel P. Huntington, *The Clash of Civilizations and the Remaking of World Order* (New York: Simon & Schuster, 1996, pp. 26–27).
