WA State Department of Health Summer Pathways Internship	Students interested in working in the field of public health.
Congressional Hispanic Leadership Institute Global Leaders Program	Applicants must be enrolled in a four-year college as a sophomore, junior, or senior. DACA students must prove their eligibility to work in the United States.
American Civil Liberties Union Internships	The ACLU offers more than 30 internships for graduate and undergraduate students committed to civil rights and social justice.
American Federation of Teachers Internships	The AFT offers internships across departments like higher education, human rights and community relations, and international affairs.
Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute Congressional Internship Program	Enables interns to work with public policy professionals to develop initiatives affecting Latino/as. Applicants must be enrolled in an undergraduate program.
INROADS Internship Program	Offers multiple internships for undergraduates majoring in select subjects at regionally accredited universities.
Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities National Internship Program	Students enrolled in a degree-seeking program at an accredited institution with a minimum 3.0 GPA. DACA-eligible applicants may qualify if they can prove their eligibility to work in the United States.
LatinoJustice's Corporate/Law Firm Alliance Summer Program	LatinoJustice's CLASP program offers paid internships at premier New York law firms for first-year law students with a minimum 3.0 GPA enrolled in one of 13 approved East Coast-based universities.
Diverse Voices in Science Journalism Internship	Students committed to diversity and interested in pursuing science journalism as a career.
American College of Healthcare Executives Diversity Internship	Students who have completed one year of graduate studies and are currently enrolled in a healthcare or association management program
First Generation Civil Rights Fellowship Program	First-generation undergraduate students who intend to pursue careers in social justice.
WA Sea Grant Applied Sustainability Internships	WA undergraduate student with junior or senior standing in business, economics, engineering, environmental science, green chemistry, physical science or sustainability science.
Parker Dewey Micro-Internships	Micro-internships can range from 5 to 40 hours of work, and go across departments including sales, marketing, technology, HR, and finance.
DreamBuilders Internships	Paid internship hosted by a TheDream.US Alumni
