


Youth Trout Fishing Day Survey Results




How many youth did you take fishing on Youth Trout Fishing Day? 125 responses




What location did you fish during the Youth Trout Fishing Day?



Were trout caught during the Youth Trout Fishing Day trip? 125 responses




How many total trout were harvested by the youth that accompanied you? 78 responses
