

Resources for Global Child Thrive Act Implementation

Background

The Global Child Thrive Act, which became law in January 2021, directs U.S. government agencies to integrate inclusive early childhood development (ECD) interventions into current and new U.S. foreign assistance programs that serve vulnerable children and their families. The law calls on the U.S. government to implement a comprehensive, coordinated approach to ECD programs within U.S. foreign development and humanitarian assistance. These resources have been created by the Thrive Coalition to aid implementation efforts in-country.
