NATIONAL MEETINGS: ANALYSIS OF THE COMMISSION'S COMMUNICATION REGARDING THE ECI "END THE CAGE AGE"



Taking into consideration the scope of the Project, each partner University's team organized a meeting with the respective students in order to analyze the Commission's Communication regarding the ECI "End the Cage Age".

The "End the Cage Age" Initiative is the sixth European Citizens' Initiative to reach the minimum number of signatures required by the Treaties (one million signatures). The Initiative calls out the inhumane treatment of farm animals through the use of cages and aims at enabling the implementation of cage-free systems which would improve the welfare of farm animals.

In each meeting, the students reflected on the ECI's organizers' arguments, on the Commission's conclusions, on the legal and political framework and on the ECI's impact. Furthermore, each University planned dynamic activities regarding the ECI and its analysis with the purpose of boosting teamwork and critical thinking.
