Farmers and Advisors in Finland



- Year 2016: 50 288 farms in Finland
- Average field size in 2014: 42,96 hectares (1,5 hectares more than in 2013)
- Field area total: 2,2 million hectares
- Advisors: approx. 550 advisors: 100 private (very unofficial number) and 450 in the biggest advisory company ProAgria
- Advisors for resource efficiency: no official numbers, maybe 200 advisors???
- Advice paid by farmers and by RPD


Financed by RDP 2014-2020



- New advisory payment system in Finland
- The amount available for advisory <u>per farm</u>: doubled in 2017 from 3 500 € → 7 000 € (during the program period)
- Advisory events approx. (spring 2017):
 18 000 visits
- Adviced farms(spring 2017): 10 600 farms
- Payments (spring 2017): 4 247 668 €
- Average payment per advisory: 244 €


Project example

- Communication project 2017-2018
- Tailored information about soil management for the specific needs of the region
- Run by Baltic Sea Action Group (ngo)
- Group of farmers makes the decisions of the contents of communication
- Local project of 3 municipalities, 1200 farmers
