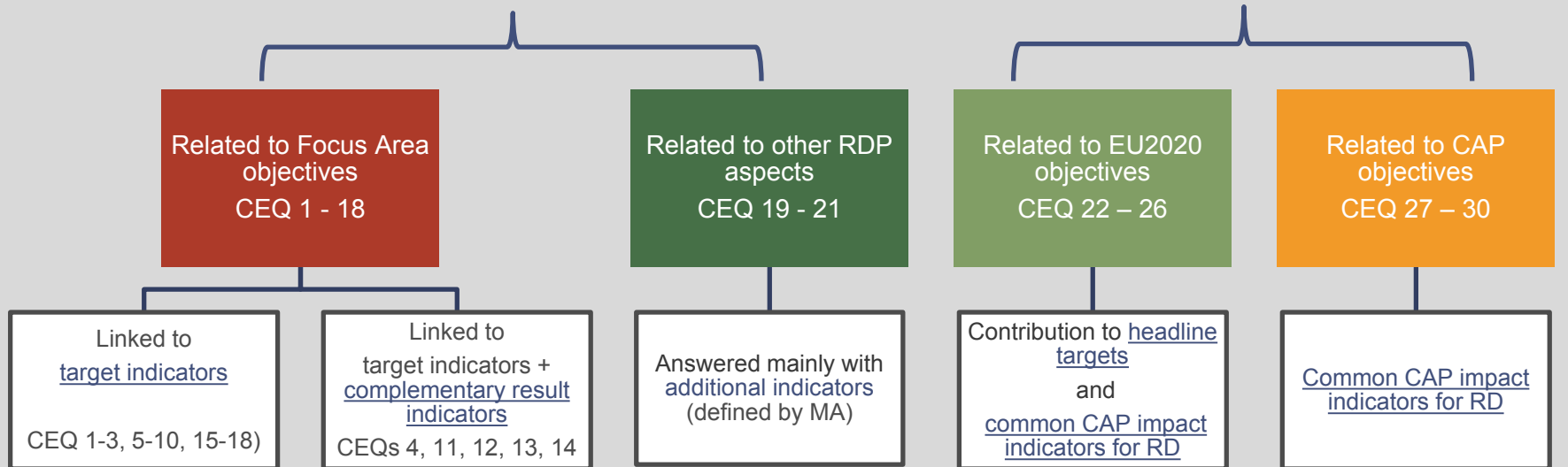

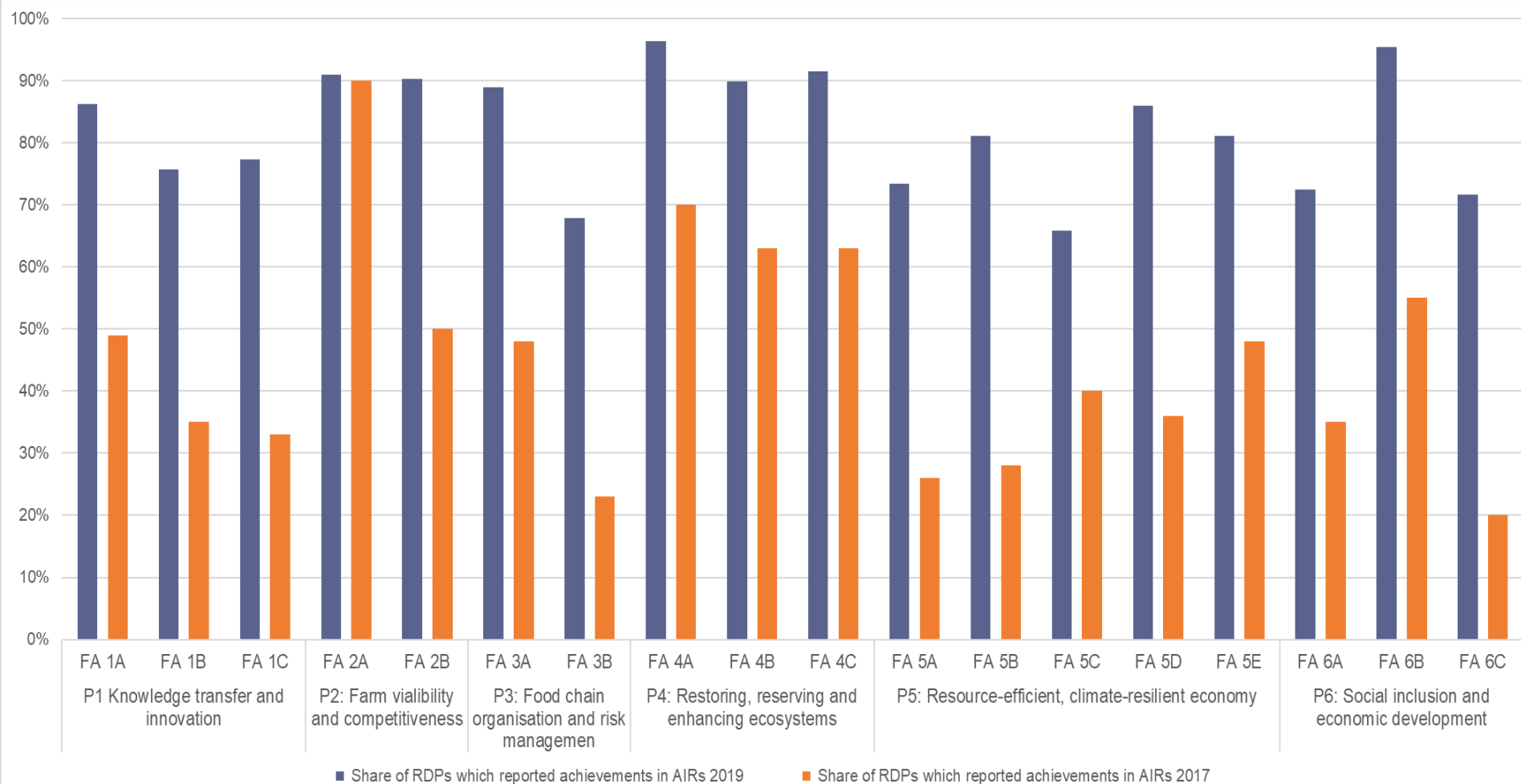

RDP impacts assessed in 2019 and ex-post

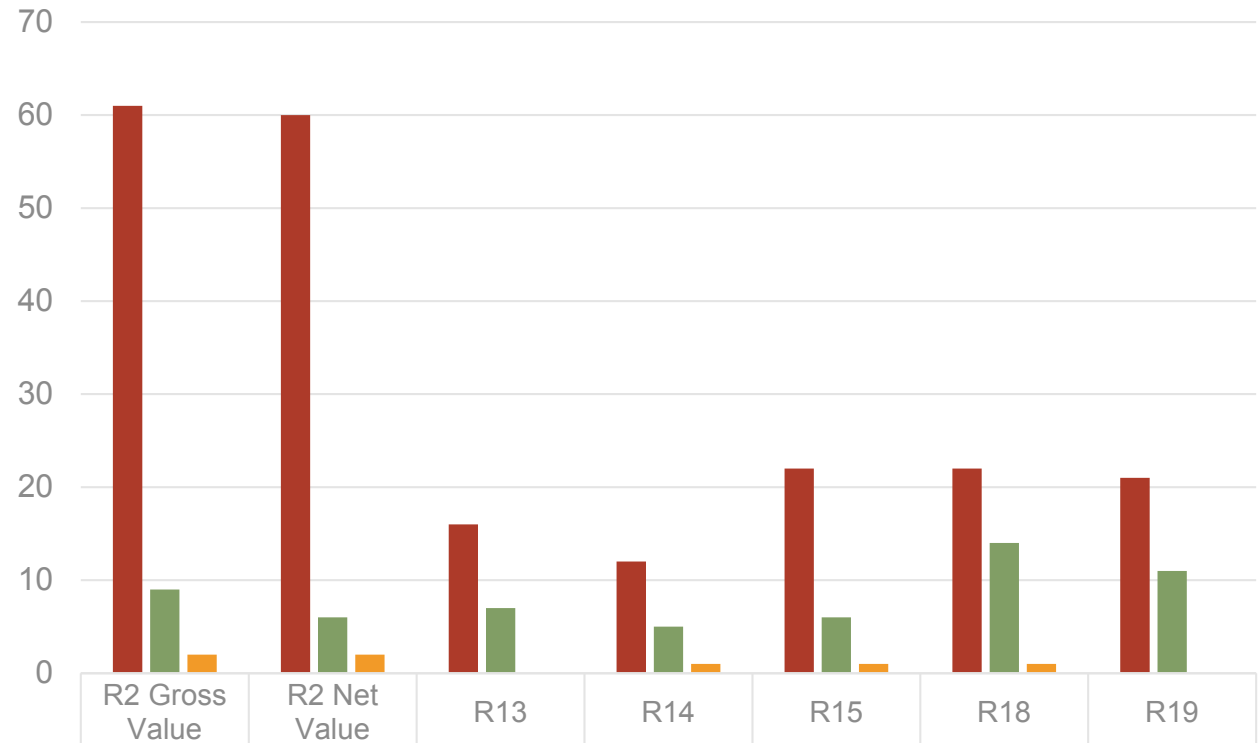


Level of reporting: FA-related CEQ

SYNERGIES

- 107 RDPs answered
- Mainly qualitative methods (e.g. expert opinions)
- Secondary contributions were often quantified
- Synergies were assessed at level of measures and FAs

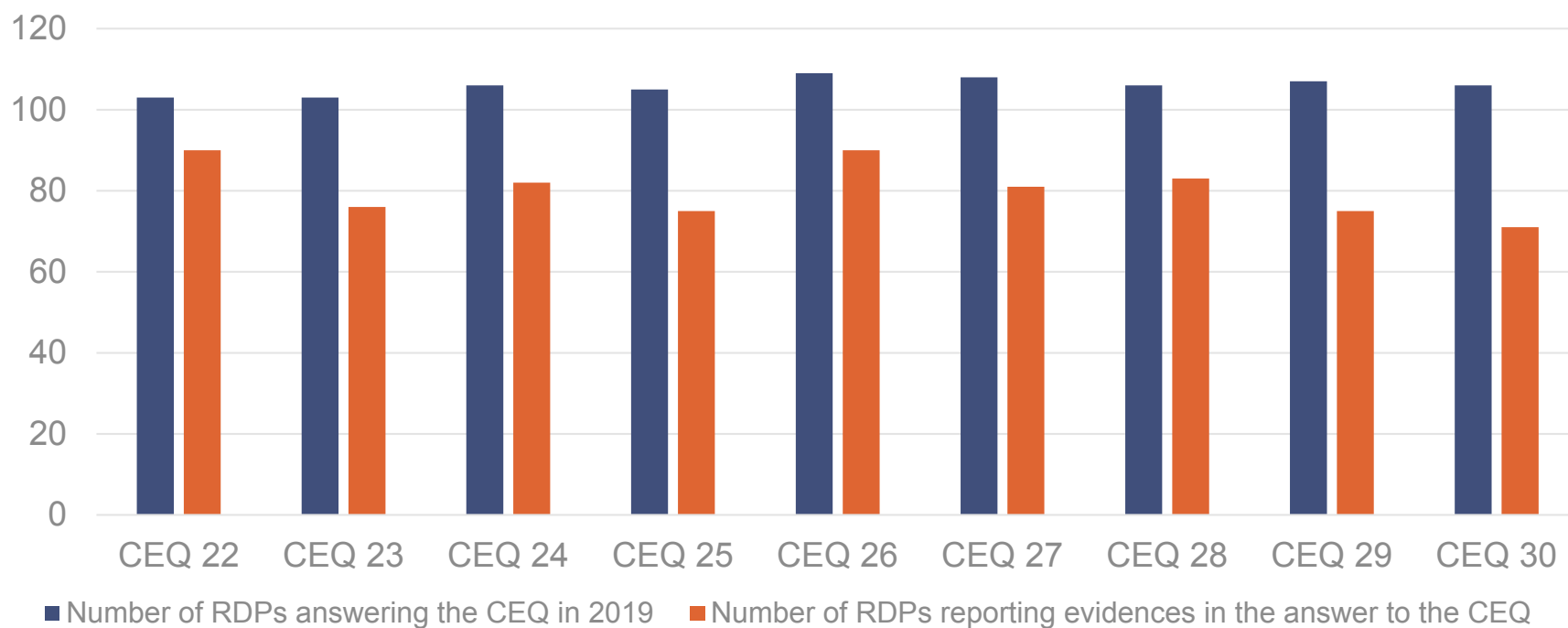
- 111 RDPs answered
- Mainly qualitative methods (e.g. surveys)
- Answers based on carried out activities and services provided to:
 - Reduce administrative burden
 - Monitoring & Eval.
 - RDP communication



NRN

- 81 RDPs answered
- Mainly qualitative (e.g. online surveys)
- Answers based on activities, services, tools to:
 - Involve stakeholders
 - Improve RDP implementation
 - Communication
 - Fostering innovation

Level of reporting: RDPs contributions to Union Level objectives



Overall, Managing Authorities reported the RDPs contributions to Union Level objectives, however the assessment of **net** contributions was limited.
