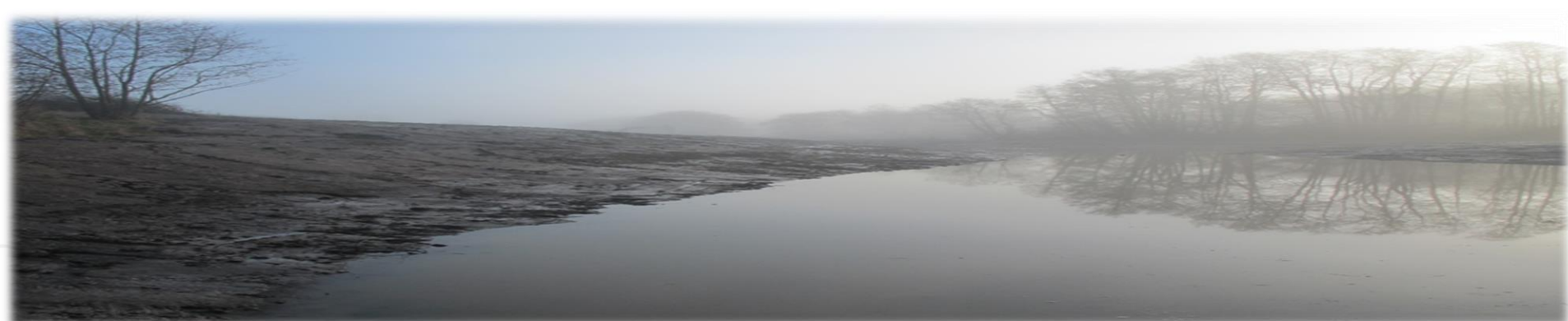
Co-operation

CLLD

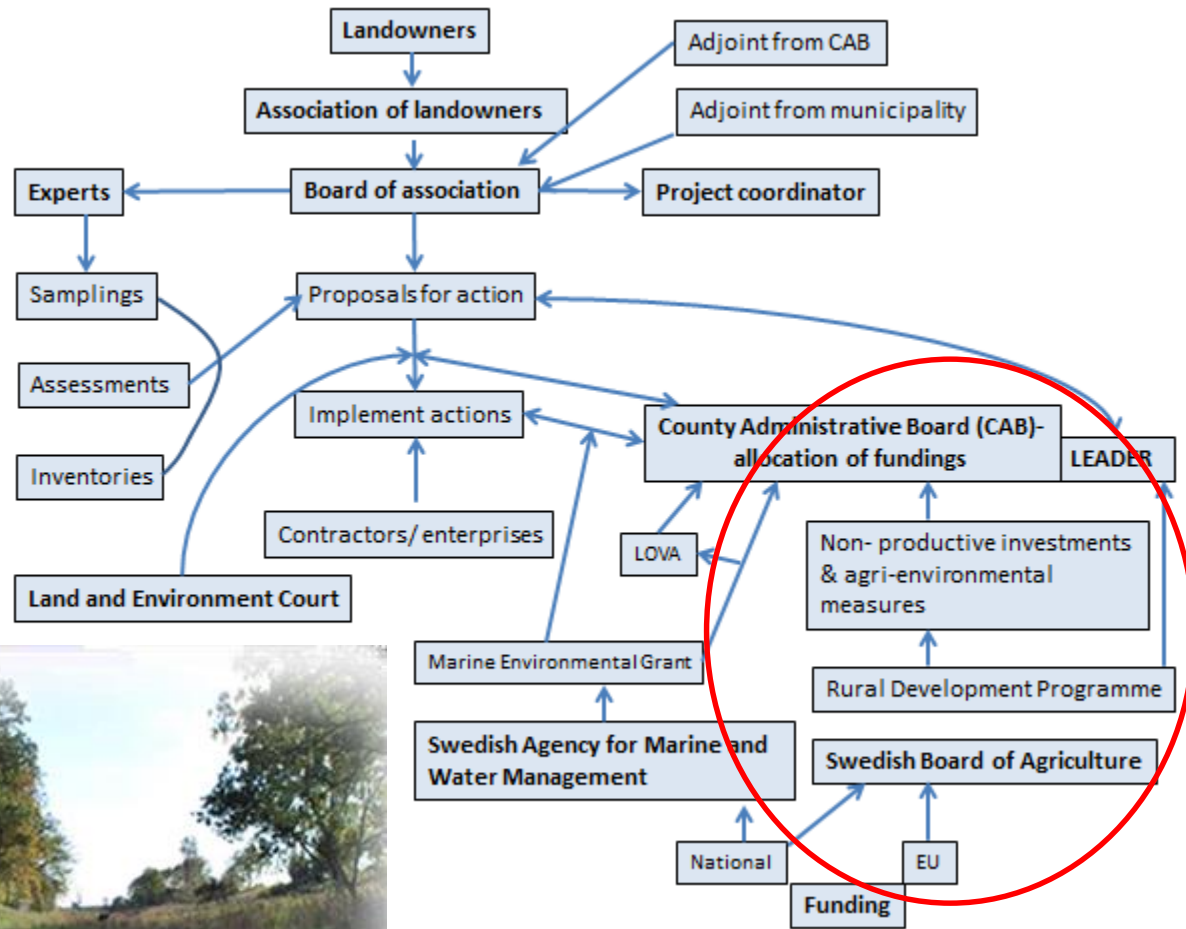
Projects that aim to:

- Develop tourism next to waters (fishing, guiding, recreation etc)
- Give access to nature,
- Clean water from waste, pollution, humic acids, algae
- Host art exhibition- "waterart"
- Develop activities for children
- Coordinate water-related activities
- Maintain wetlands
- Develop meeting points for environment- and/or energy projects

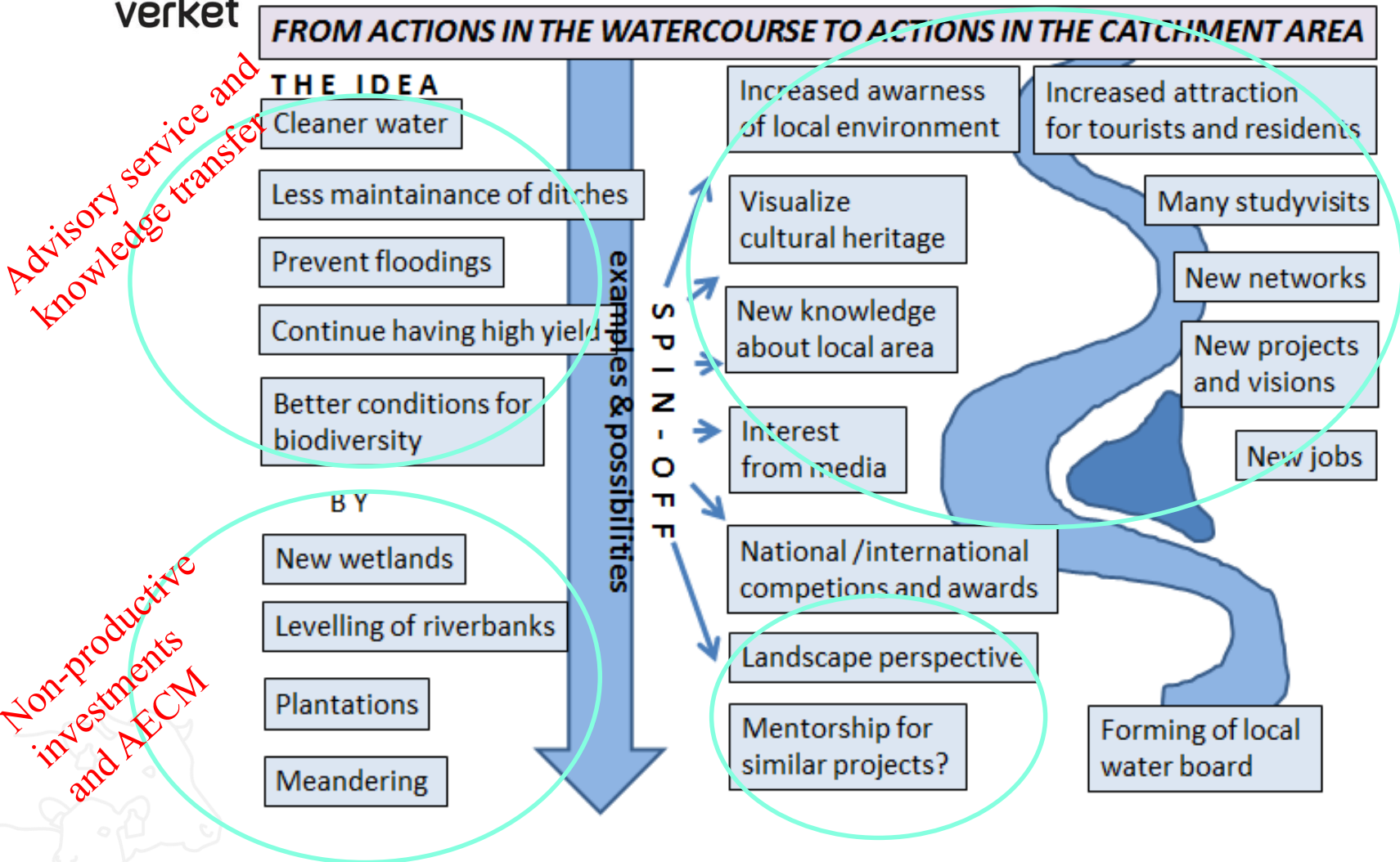
Added value
