Established by the European Commission

European Research Council (ERC) funding schemes are open to top researchers of any nationality or age who wish to carry out their frontier research in the 28 EU Member States or associated countries.

# Grants & Fellowships 1 European Union

#### 1.1 Horizon 2020

Horizon 2020 is the European Commission Framework Programme for Research and Innovation. It is the biggest EU Research and Innovation programme ever with nearly €80 billion of funding available over 7 years (2014 to 2020) – in addition to the private investment that this money will attract.

The Brazilian National Council of State Funding Agencies (CONFAP) listed <u>potential calls of interest for EU-Brazil cooperation</u> in order to encourage the participation of Brazilian researchers under Horizon 2020 calls,

Several FAPs (<u>FAPESP</u>, <u>FAPESC</u>, <u>FAPEG</u>, <u>FAPEMIG</u>, <u>FAPDF</u>) expressed interest in funding researchers from their states to support their participation in H2020 calls and published <u>guidelines</u> with insttructions to this end.

#### 1.2 H2020 SME Innovation Associate

Matching SMEs and researchers with a new programme to support 90 SMEs who can hire a researcher of any nationality to bring their brilliant idea to life.

For the time being the call is mainly for European SMEs but <u>EURAXESS</u> <u>Jobs</u> already offers the possibility to pre-check the attractiveness of (future) job vacancies under H2020 SME Innovation Associate. These can be easily found by filtering the job search by the 'SME Innovation Associate'.

Deadline 30 June 2016.

### 1.3 ERC Advanced Grants - call open!

ERC Advanced Grants are designed to support excellent Principal Investigators at the career stage at which they are already established research leaders with a recognised track record of research achievements. This action is open to researchers of any nationality who intend to conduct their research activity in any Member State or Associated Country.

The ERC's frontier research grants operate on a 'bottom-up' basis without predetermined priorities. The call 'ERC-2016-ADG' consists of **one call with a single deadline** applying to each of the three main research domains:

- Physical Sciences & Engineering
- Life Sciences
- Social Sciences & Humanities.

**Eligibility**: any nationality, any age. Applicants must be leaders in their respective field(s) of research and must demonstrate significant achievement in the last 10 years

Currently over 420 ERC grantees out of nearly 5,300 are non-Europeans (i.e 8%of total). Research teams set up by ERC grantees are highly international – an estimated 17% of team members are non-Europeans.

**Location:** research must be conducted in a public or private research organisation (known as a Host Institution/HI). It could be the HI where the applicant already works, or any other HI located in one of the EU <u>Member States</u> or <u>Associated Countries</u>

**Funding:** up to € 2.5 million per grant (up to € 3.5 million in some cases)

Duration: up to 5 years

Sole evaluation criterion: scientific excellence of researcher and research

posal

**Deadline: 1 September 2016.** For more details on Advanced grants, see **ERC website** and **call details**.

#### Important notice: Time to spend on the project

Researchers applying for ERC-funding must be **strongly committed** to the project and spend a significant amount of time on it. However, it is not obligatory to spend 100% of your time in Europe whilst carrying out the ERC-funded research.

For Advanced Grants, the Principal Investigator should devote at least 30% of her/his working time to the ERC project and spend at least 50% of her/his total working time in a EU Member State or Associated Country.

### 1.4 Fellowships for research stays at the European University Institute (EUI)

#### 1.4.1 Jean Monnet Postdoctoral Fellowships

The Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies (RSCAS) offers one or twoyear fellowships to postdocs of all nationalities who have obtained their doctorate more than 5 years prior to the start of the fellowship, i.e. 1 September 2016 for the academic year 2016/17. The Fellowship programme is open to post-docs, tenure track academics and those wishing to spend their sabbatical at the Robert Schuman Centre.

The three main research themes of the RSCAS are:

- Integration, Governance and Democracy;
- Regulating Markets and Governing Money;
- 21st Century World Politics and Europe

Deadline: 25 October.

#### 1.4.2 Fernand Braudel Incoming Senior Fellowships

Fellowships last for up to ten months in one of the EUI's four Departments which in turn invite fellows to participate in departmental activities (seminars, workshops, colloquia, etc.).

Fellows are encouraged to make contact with researchers sharing their academic interests, may be involved in the teaching and thesis supervision tasks of EUI professors, and associated with one of the research projects being carried out at the EUI.

Next deadline: 30 September.

### 1.5 <u>Human Frontier Science Programme (HFSP)</u> Postdoctoral fellowships

HFSP postdoctoral fellowships encourage early career scientists to broaden their research skills by moving into **new areas** of study while working in a **new country**. Two possibilities:

- Long-Term Fellowships (LTF) are for applicants with a Ph.D. in a biological discipline, who will broaden their expertise by proposing a project in the life sciences which is significantly different from their previous Ph.D. or postdoctoral work.
- Cross-Disciplinary Fellowships (CDF) are for applicants with a Ph.D. from outside the life sciences (e.g. in physics, chemistry, mathematics, engineering or computer sciences), who have had limited exposure to biology during their previous training.

HFSP fellowships are for **three years**. Fellows may choose to stay for up to three years in the host country or use the last year of their fellowship to return to their home country or to move to another HFSPO member country.

Next deadline: 25 August 2016

### 1.6 European Respiratory Society (ERS) - <u>Short-Term</u> Research Training Fellowships

The ERS allow young scientists and clinicians to visit a host institution in Europe. Short term stays of 1-3 months are supported.

**All nationalities**, European and non- European based candidates are allowed to submit a project proposal

Next deadlines: 1 October 2016; 1 April 2017.

### 1.7 EMBO Courses and Workshops

EMBO offers the largest number of life science events in Europe. EMBO Courses & Workshops funds approximately 80 events attracting more than 8,000 participants every year.

Funding is available to organise conferences, EMBO | EMBL Symposia, workshops, EMBO | FEBS Lecture Courses, Global Exchange Lecture Courses and practical courses, as well as for keynote lectures. <a href="Travel grants">Travel grants</a> support the attendance of participants from countries with less-developed scientific infrastructures. EMBO assists the organizer with the design of a poster, set-up of a website and registration system, and with promotion of the event.

Next deadline: 1 August 2016



HFSP fellowships are open to candidates of all nationalities. Those who are not nationals from one of the supporting countries may apply to work only in a research institution in one of the supporting countries.

The SMART<sup>2</sup> Project is jointly coordinated CentraleSupélec and Universidade Federal de Itajubá (UNIFEI) in Brazil and composed of 18 members: 10 EU partners Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, France, Finland, Germany, Italy, The Netherlands, Portugal and Spain, and 8 Brazilian partners, plus 3 associated partners (T.I.M.E. Association, Ecole Centrale de Lille and BTP Rincent).

The SMART<sup>2</sup> project is an **ERASMUS** MUNDUS Partnership (EMA2 strand1) project funded by European commission

#### 1.8 EBW+ (Erasmus Mundus) scholarships for sandwich PhD in Europe open to Brazilian young researchers

The third EBW+ project call is only supporting PhD mobility of 6 and 10 months period in the following areas:

- Engineering, Technology
- Creative arts (music, design, dance and cinema).

The call is open to PhD students from Brazilian universities, being members of the consortium or not. Please, note that From the Brazilian side, no scholarships are available for UFRGS. From the European side. no scholarships are available to U.Porto, UTAD, UPV and UNIROMA.

Deadline: 31 August 2016

### 1.9 BE Mundus (Erasmus Mundus) - open call for sandwich PhD

Scholarships for Brazilian PhDs students to undertake a mobility period (6 months) in 9 prestigious European universities, with the financial support of the European Commission's Erasmus Mundus programme.

The scholarships cover: Monthly allowance (PhDs: 1.500 EUR); Travel expenses; Full insurance scheme; Tuition fees (if applicable). At the end of the mobility period, the young researchers will return to their home university, where the research carried out abroad will be recognized as part of the research programme at their home university.

WHO? Open to Brazilian doctorate students.

Deadline: 15 September 2016.

1.10SMART<sup>2</sup> Project (Erasmus Mundus) - open call for a mobility period in Europe (PhD mobility, post doctorate, academic and administrative staff)

SMART2 (SmartCities & SmartGrids for Sustainable Development) aims at strengthening academic collaborations between Brazil and Europe and will finance mobilities for engineering students, doctorates, post-doctorates and staff. The priority areas of the program will include engineering, technology, computer science, mathematics, architecture and planning.

The SMART<sup>2</sup> project is currently receiving applications to award mobility fellowships to spend a study or research period in Europe.

This project only concerns Brazilian applicants. It is not necessary to study in one of the Higher education institutions to take part in the mobility scheme.

Deadline: 8 June 2016



IBRASIL consortium The which stands for "Inclusive and Innovative Brazil" has emerged from a long and mature collaboration between Brazilian and European universities. It is composed of 11 Brazilian and 9 European Higher Education Institutions from different countries where various languages spoken: Spanish, Portuguese, French, Romanian, Italian, German, Slovak and Greek.

Besides providing information on funding opportunities for incoming international and European researchers, staff at the EURAXESS Service Centres offer individual assistance on all aspects of researcher mobility.

International Prize in recognition of outstanding achievements in biomedical research (award of 250,000 euros). The theme for 2017 is "Neurological diseases".

# 1.11 IBRASIL (Erasmus Mundus) - <u>Sandwich PhD and</u> <u>post-doctorate scholarships in engineering and</u> technology

The EU funded **IBRASIL project "Inclusive and Innovative Brazil"** (Erasmus Mundus Action 2 program) grants **scholarships to Brazilian and European students** for credits mobility and degree mobility within the Higher Education Institutions members of the IBRASIL network.

Scholarships are now available for sandwich doctorates and post-doctorates (6 to 10 months) in the fields of Engineering & Technology.

European candidates can only apply to sandwich doctorates. Brazilian candidates can apply either to PhD or post-doc mobility to Europe.

Deadline: 30 June 2016.

#### 1.12EURAXESS Jobs

There are currently **around 9750 research jobs and fellowship programmes** (all over Europe, but also in other countries such as in Brazil and in all disciplines) announced on the <u>EURAXESS Jobs database</u>. Opportunities can be viewed by country, level of seniority, field or research or via free text searches. Please note that these jobs also include doctoral fellowships.

#### 2.1 National EURAXESS Portals

### 2.2 BELGIUM - BAILLET LATOUR Health Prize Call for nominations

This personal award is intended to recognize outstanding scientific achievements in biomedical research for the benefit of human health and to encourage the laureate in the pursuit of his/her career. The Prize is open to scientists of all nationalities who have not received an equivalent Prize for their personal use.

Exceptionally, the Prize may be shared between two persons who have collaborated over a long period. The laureate will be selected by an international Jury in February 2017.

The themes for the following years will be: Cancer (2018), Cardiovascular Diseases (2019), Metabolic Disorders (2020), Infectious Diseases (2021).

Deadline: 30 September 2016.

### 2.3 DENMARK - <u>Eighth Call for Proposals for</u> International Network Activities with Brazil

Support for bilateral network activities seeking to identify potential for new bilateral research collaboration with different countries, including Brazil

WHO? Scientists from Denmark and from one or more of the following countries: China (incl. Hong Kong), India, Israel, Japan, USA, Brazil, Turkey, South Africa and the Republic of Korea

What is funded? Operating expenses for workshops and conferences, international travel and research stay for a shorter period up to 90 days in the selected countries or in Denmark

Duration of research stays: Up to 90 days

Deadline: 24 August 2016

#### 2.4 French chairs in the State of Minas Gerais

The Federal University of the State of Minas Gerais (UFMG) and the French Embassy launched a call for applications for a French Chair in the State of Minas Gerais. The call is open to professors or researchers from French higher education and research institutions in all research areas. They must be codirected by a Brazilian professor.

Deadline: 5 June 2016.

### 2.5 GERMANY - <u>Sofja Kovalevskaja Award</u> of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation

This award aims to supports particularly promising young researchers from abroad. Award-winners receive **up to 1.65 million Euros over a period of five years**, to be spent on any research project they choose. This allows them to establish their own working group at a research institution of their choice in Germany and to cover their own costs of living. The award is funded by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF).

WHO? Open to Brazil-based researchers who have completed their PhD (or equivalent academic qualification) within the past six years and hold an outstanding academic track record.

Deadline: 31 July 2016.

#### 2.6 ITALY - EURAC Federal Scholar In Residence

For comparative research at the European Academy of Bolzano/Bozen (EURAC) and aims at weaving experts and their networks in order to develop and advance comparative federal and regional studies.

The program welcomes applications from academics, post-docs and practitioners in federalism, regionalism and intergovernmental relations.

Deadline of submission: 01 July 2016.

### 2.7 ITALY - Scuola Normale Superiore PhD courses

The **Scuola Normale Superiore** (SNS) offers **fully funded PhD** programmes in a **variety of fields** including humanities, social sciences, natural sciences and engineering,

Students of any nationality who hold or expect to obtain their master's degree by 31 October 2016 may apply for the PhD courses.

Successful applicants will receive **full financial support** (tuition fees, monthly allowance) for the **entire duration of the course: 3 years** (4 years in the neuroscience and biophysical fields).

Two calls per year. Next deadline: 30 August 2016

### 2.8 NETHERLANDS (KNAW) - Evert Willem Beth Foundation: funding for research and symposiums

The Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW) Evert Willem Beth Foundation funds some research and symposiums in the following disciplines: modern logic, philosophy of science, history of logic, history of the philosophy of science and scientific philosophy in general.

### 2.12.1 UK (British Council) - Brazil (Confap & Fapesp) - Researcher Connect call to develop researchers communication skills

The British Council and Confap launched a call under the Researcher Connect programme, funded by the Newton Fund. The call aims at selecting higher education institutions in 15 Brazilian states to host workshops on scientific communication.



This call is co-financed by the European Commission

Researcher Connect is a series of short interactive learning modules for researchers at any stage of their career and from any academic discipline. It is a professional development course that focuses on the development of excellent communication skills in international, multi-cultural contexts.

Researcher Connect was developed to help researchers meet the demands of an increasingly competitive global market, where the ability to communicate research effectively is paramount to success.

Elegible proposals from the States of: São Paulo - Paraná - Distrito Federal - Goiás - Minas Gerais - Pernambuco - Espírito Santo - Sergipe - Tocantins - Mato Grosso do Sul - Pará - Piauí - Alagoas - Paraíba - Santa Catarina.

Deadline: 27 June 2016.

#### 2.12.2 UK - Newton Fund Institutional Links grants

<u>Newton Institutional Links</u> aims to build UK-partner country research and innovation collaborations centred on shared research and innovation challenges which have direct relevance to social welfare and economic development.

Newton Institutional Links grants provide **small-scale seed funding for collaborations** between the UK and Brazil, among other.

This programme is designed to establish links beyond the level of the individual researcher and innovation practitioner, opening up opportunities for more sustainable, solution-oriented collaborations between **academic groups as well as with the private and third sector** (e.g. SMEs, NGOs, technology transfer offices and other not-for-profit organisations).

WHO? Each proposal must have one Principal Applicant from the UK, as well as a Principal Applicant from Brazil. They must be Leading Researchers or Established Researchers.

### 2.12.3 UK (British Council / Newton Fund) - Brazil (CONFAP) Researcher Links Scientific Workshop call

WHAT? **Call** for research workshop proposals under Newton Fund Researcher Links to propose 3 to 5 days bilateral workshops, which will bring together early career researchers from the UK and Brazil to discuss their research and start to build international relationships in the following themes:

- Agriculture.
- Climate and Environment,
- Energy,
- Education,
- Economic growth,
- Neglected Diseases,
- Water and Sanitation,
- Food and Nutrition,
- Demographic change,

- urbanisation and human rights, and urban transformation.

During the visit, they pursue a small joint research project. Continuous application.

SWITZERLAND (SNSF) – outgoing fellowships for Swiss nationals or permanent residents:

- Doc.mobility, for doctoral students. Deadlines: 1 September
- <u>Early Post-doc.Mobility</u>: for postdocs at the beginning of their career. Deadlines: **1 September**
- Advanced Postdoc.Mobility for advanced postdocs. Deadline:1
   August

SWITZERLAND - Swiss National Science Foundation <u>International Exploratory Workshops</u>. Researchers in Switzerland who wish to organise workshops with participants from abroad. Next deadlines: 1 June 2016 and 5 october 2016.

TURKEY – TÜBITAK Fellowships for Visiting Scientists and Scientists on Sabbatical Leave to give seminars/conferences/lectures, or engage in R&D activities for 1 month to 12 month visits. Next deadline: rolling basis.

UK - <u>Imperial College PhD scholarship programme 2016-2017</u> for research **students** in their chosen research field. The earliest start date for funded places is **1 August 2016**.

UK (Royal Society) - <u>International Exchanges Scheme</u> to support one-off visit or bilateral travel in order to Strengthen third countries Research Links with a UK Partner. **Deadline: 7 June 2016 and 18 October 2016.** 

#### 4.3 Brazil

FAPESP funds collaborative research under the Horizon 2020 (H2020) programme. Researchers eligible for funding by the São Paulo Research Foundation (FAPESP) can use the normal modes of funding offered by the foundation to support their participation in H2020 proposals under Thematic Project, Regular Project, and Young Investigator Award, to be chosen by the proposer. Deadline: any time by FAPESP, but following the deadlines for H2020 calls.

BRAZIL (FAPESP/CONFAP/MCTI) <u>fund Brazilian researchers participation in biofuels under Horizon 2020 call (advanced lignocellulosic biofuels.)</u>
WHO? Applicants in Brazil, must meet the conditions and restrictions of the FAPESP Programme for Research Partnerships for Technological Innovation (PITE), described at <u>www.fapesp.br/pite</u>. **Deadline: 8 September 2016.** 

BRAZIL - <u>Visiting professor programme</u> at the Institute of Advanced Studies of the University of São Paulo (IEA/USP).



H2020 proposals can include researchers, academic and non-academic institutions (including enterprises) from countries outside the European Union.

CAPES – <u>International cooperation programme (PGCI)</u> to support joint research projects and partnerships with universities from countries with whom Brazil has international agreements but with whom Capes has not. It includes sandwich PhD and post-doc mobility. **Rolling basis**.

BRAZIL – <u>CAPES School of advanced studies</u> funds the incoming mobility of prestigious foreign researchers to hold monographic courses in Brazil. WHO? applications must be submitted by post-graduation programmes, individually or in consortium. Deadline: **30 November 2016**.

BRAZIL - CAPES <u>General Programme for International Cooperation</u>. Support joint research projects and university partnerships between Brazilian higher education institutions and those which promote graduate training (Sandwich PhD and Post-Doc) and improvement for professors and researchers, located in countries with which Brazil has signed international agreements. WHO? **Deadline: 31 August 2016; 30 November 2016.** 

BRAZIL— CAPES-Humboldt Researcher Fellowships. for postdoctoral researchers (6-24 months) for researchers from Brazil who have completed their doctorate in the last four years and for experienced researchers to carry out a long-term research project (6-18 months) with Germany for researchers from Brazil who completed their doctorate less than twelve years ago and work at least at the level of Assistant Professor or Junior Research Group Leader, or have a record of several years of independent academic work. Next deadlines: 29 July 2016 and 30 December 2016.

BRAZIL – <u>FAPESP Visiting Researcher Programme</u> offers full or partial support for the hosting of experienced investigators, associated with foreign research institutions for a period from 2 weeks to a maximum period of 12 months. The visiting and host researchers must hold a PhD degree and have an outstanding record of scientific accomplishments. Proposals can be submitted at any time by investigators associated with higher education and research institutions in the State of São Paulo.

UK (BBSRC) – BRAZIL (FAPESP) - <u>pump-priming awards</u> to new collaborations between research groups in the State of São Paulo, Brazil and BBSRC funded research groups in the UK. Priority will be given to applications in the area **of food security and/or Bioenergy and Industrial Biotechnology**. WHO? Applications **must** be made by a Principle Investigator (PI) currently in receipt of BBSRC research funding. Deadline: **anytime**.

In 2014, 199 proposals received funding out of a total of 243 submissions evaluated.
