In August 2018, the Commission adopted Recommendation C(2018) 5488 on a coordinated control plan for the official controls on online sales of dogs and cats. Member States could implement the recommendation from October to November 2018 and send their results until February 2019. The Commission will present a summary of the consolidated results of the participant countries and the suggestions made following their inspections.

A.09 Presentation by Romania of the equine infectious anaemia situation with a view to possible regionalisation. (AEF/ROM)

In accordance with Decision 2010/346/EU, specific measures apply to the movement of equidae from the entire territory of Romania to other Member States as regards pre-movement isolation and testing, as well as surveillance for equine infectious anaemia (EIA). As a result of the control measures implemented by Romania, the incidence of EIA in certain parts of Romania has substantially decreased. It is the purpose of the presentation by Romania to explore, together with Member States, the possibility of applying the protection measures laid down in Decision 2010/346/EU only to a part of the territory of Romania, as it is envisaged in the text of the Decision and its Annex.
