## LONELINESS IN EUROPE Determinants, Risks and Interventions

Loneliness, often referred to as the 'epidemic of the 21st century', has emerged as a serious public health concern. For years, a lack of comprehensive European cross-national data hindered a thorough examination of this issue. In 2022, the European Commission's Joint Research Centre conducted the inaugural EU Loneliness Survey, covering around 30,000 individuals in 27 European nations.

During this book launch, the authors will present a synthesis of first results of this survey with the aim to inform what is at stake, to discuss the societal impact of loneliness and to highlight future pathways for monitoring and investigating loneliness in Europe.
