Entry Criteria

To apply for this programme, you must meet the following requirements:

Age and height

Age 17 to apply Age 18 to commence training. Minimum height 5 ft. 2 in. (157 cm) Maximum height 6 ft. 3 in. (191 cm)

Education and English language

Passes all 13 ATPL Theoretical Knowledge exams. Be fluent in English (verbal and written)

Medical

Be able to obtain:

- 1. EASA Class 1 Medical without restrictions for Irish IAA Licence: or
- 2. UKCAA Class 1 Medical without restrictions for UKCAA Licence

- > Unrestricted right to live, study and work in the U.K. (e.g. U.K. national, EU national with settled or pre-settled status)
- > If required: Meet the United Kingdom Visa & Immigration Service requirements to qualify for a Visitor (study for six months or less) or Student Visa (study for more than six months)
- > If required, obtain / be able to obtain M-1 Student Visa for your flight training in the U.S.

Background and selection

- > Produce a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) certificate before training can commence
- > Pass L3Harris' selection process


