## ENTRY CRITERIA

**To apply for the L3Harris Airline Academy IndiGo Cadet Pilot Program you must meet the following requirements:**

- > Must be between 18 and 34 years and 364 days at the point of application
- > Fluent in English (verbal and written)
- > Able to obtain and maintain Indian DGCA and FAA Class 1 Medical Certificate
- > No visible tattoos or body piercings
- > BMI range of 18 to 25 (normal weight category)
- > Have a valid passport and the unrestricted right to live and work in India, with the ability to travel unrestricted worldwide
- > Pass all IndiGo referencing checks and L3Harris selection process
- > Must have access to the full funding required for this course\*

## ACADEMIC ENTRY STANDARDS

Minimum Education Qualification: 10+2 with minimum score of 51% in each of the following subjects: Physics, Maths, English
