To apply for this programme, you must meet the following requirements:

Experience

Commercial Pilot Licence with Instrument Rating.

Age and height

Aged 17 to apply and at least aged 18 to commence training.

Minimum height 5 ft. 2 in. (157 cm).

Maximum height 6 ft. 3 in. (191 cm).

Education and English language

Fluent in English (spoken and written).

Non-native English speakers must achieve level 5.5 individual and overall in IELTS or equivalent ICAO level 4 prior to start of training.

Medical

Be able to obtain: UKCAA or EASA unrestricted Class 1 Medical.

Visas

Unrestricted right to live, study and work in the UK (e.g. UK national, EU national with settled or pre-settled status).

If required: Meet the United Kingdom Visa & Immigration Service requirements to qualify for a Visitor (study for six months or less) or Student visa (study for more than six months).

Background and selection

Cut-e testing and a competency interview, if you haven't done so already through a previous modular application. If an interview has been carried out previously then a confirmatory interview will take place.
