Experience

UKCAA or EASA PPL holder

Age and height

Aged 17 to apply and at least aged 18 to commence training.

Education and English language

Fluent in English (spoken and written).

Non-native English speakers must achieve level 5.5 individual and overall in IELTS or equivalent ICAO level 4 prior to start of training.

Medical

Be able to obtain: UKCAA or EASA unrestricted Class 1 Medical.

Visas

Unrestricted right to live, study and work in the UK (e.g. UK national, EU national with settled or pre-settled status).

If required: Meet the United Kingdom Visa & Immigration Service requirements to qualify for a Visitor (study for six months or less) or Student visa (study for more than six months).
