Resolution 2024-16
Amending the Town of Millington
Chapter 48 – Peace & Good Order

WHEREAS, the Town Charter of the Town of Millington allows for the passing of all such ordinances not contrary to the Constitution and laws of the State of Maryland as it may deem necessary for the good government of the Town; for the protection and preservation of the Town’s property, rights and privileges: for the preservation of peace and good order; for securing persons and property from violence, danger or destruction: and for the protection and promotion of the health, safety, comfort, convenience, welfare and happiness of the residents of the Town and visitors thereto and sojourners therein.

WHEREAS, Chapter 48 of the Code of the Town of Millington secures and protects the general public from premise conditions found to be dangerous or detrimental to human life, limb, health property, and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that certain sections of Chapter 48 peace and good order in the Town of Millington have been amended; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution and the attached revised Chapter 48 of the Town of Millington Code having been introduced on July 9, 2024 and a public hearing held on August 13, 2024, these revisions shall be effective as of August 13, 2024.
