This conference promotes dialogue for best practices. It gives industry and government a neutral forum to collaborate and learn with one another.

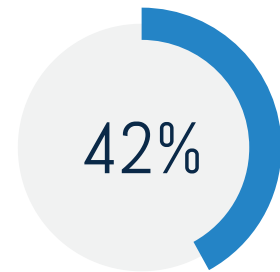
Because of this, World Congress 2024 attracts buyer and sellers across the contract management profession from all armed services, federal civilian agencies, academia, the intelligence community and industry.

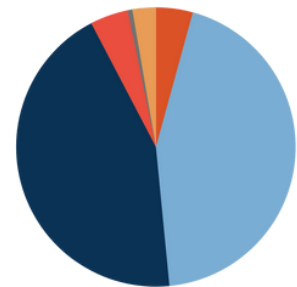
Category distribution is based on similar conference attendance
