Following the Facility for Refugees in Turkey (2016-2019), in 2020 the EU mobilised **an additional €531.7 million** to continue humanitarian support to **refugees** in Türkiye. The EU has furthermore ensured the continuation of key support to refugees in Türkiye through **an additional €3 billion** allocation for the period of 2021-2023. A total of EUR 3.53 billion has been committed, EUR 3.01 billion of this has been contracted, and EUR 1.73 billion disbursed.
