Multi-country (multi-region) projects

A **multi-country** or **multi-region** project is a **technical support project** that is **relevant** or **common** to **more than one Member State** as it belongs to the **same policy area** and addresses the **same priorities for technical support**



2 types of multi-country requests

Coordinated submission of same/similar requests by different Member States

Examples from TSI 2022:

- Micro-data platform
(*DE, FR, LV, PT, SK, SI*)
- Hub for Sustainable Investments in Health (*AT, BE, SI*)

Request submission by one Member State on behalf of other Member States

Examples from TSI 2022:

- Evidence-informed policymaking in governance & public administration
(*BE, CZ, EE, EL, FI, LT, LV, NL*)
- Anti-money laundering risk analysis and supervision
(*BE, CZ, DE, ES, FR, LV, NL*)
