Introduction

Welcome to Finpeak. Finpeak Inc. (Finpeak) operates a network of websites and a mobile application serving multiple cities in the United States. By visiting our website, using our mobile app, and accessing the information, resources, services, products, and tools we provide, you understand and agree to accept and adhere to the Finpeak Privacy Policy (hereafter referred to as the "Privacy Policy"), along with the terms and conditions as stated in our Terms of Service which is incorporated herein by reference.

This Privacy Policy has been compiled to better serve those who are concerned with how their information is being used online. Your personal information, as used in US privacy law and information security, is information that can be used on its own or with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person, or to identify an individual in context.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your personal information on our websites and mobile application, and any other resources, services, products, and tools we provide for you, either directly or indirectly (hereafter, referred to as "Services").

Section 1. Modification

We reserve the right to change the Privacy Policy from time to time. When we do so, we will provide notice to you by posting it on our website and in our mobile applications, and indicating the date it was modified. You acknowledge and agree that it is your responsibility to review the Privacy Policy periodically to familiarize yourself with any modifications.

Section 2. Information We Collect

We collect a variety of information from you when you provide it to us directly or when you tell us to get it from a third party source. The particular kinds of information we gather usually depend on how you interact with us.

For example:

- We collect basic account information such as your email address, phone number, username and password. We need this information to create your account and it helps secure and provide access to our Services. We also obtain or infer demographic information. If you use Facebook to register for or log in to the Services (or later connect your accounts), you authorize Facebook or, as the case may be, to share your personal information with us, including your email address, age and publicly available information about you and your Facebook friends, if you use Facebook for registering for the Services.
- Similarly, if you access the Services with another third party social network we will collect information that you have agreed to make available, such as your name, user ID/URL, profile picture, age, list of friends, email address and/or phone number, and/or your birthday, language selected, and/or geolocation.
- We collect additional profile information about you when you upload a picture.

- We gather information from the actions you take to recommend, create, communicate and share content. This includes messages you send, posts you create yourself, and the products you mark as favorites or share. In addition, we track social interactions in our Apps (e.g. what you bought, what you loved, and your posts and invites).
- If you send us support requests or comments you may also provide us with additional information to enable us to contact you and address your feedback, and we may retain such information to enhance our Services and to respond to you.
- When you purchase products or services from Finpeak, you provide our payment processor with your payment information. We currently use third parties to process such payments but may change that in the future.

Our Services collect information that identifies, relates to, describes, references, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or device. In particular, if we acknowledge collection of information below, the Services have collected the following categories of personal information from our consumers within the last twelve (12) months.

Section 3. When We Collect Information

We collect information from you when you register for the Services or provide information during your use of the Services.

Section 4. How We Use Your Information

We may use the information we collect from you when you register, make a purchase, sign up for our newsletter, respond to a survey or marketing communication, surf the website, or use the Services in the following ways:

- To personalize user's experience and to allow us to deliver the type of content and product offerings in which you are most interested.
- To improve our website in order to better serve you.
- To allow us to better service you in responding to your customer service requests.
- To administer a contest, promotion, survey or other site feature.
- To quickly process your transactions.
- To send periodic emails regarding your order or other products and services.

Section 5. Information for California Residents

If you are a California resident, you are entitled to request notice of certain information about the user information that we may share with third parties for marketing purposes (e.g., the categories of user information shared, and contact information of applicable third parties), as well as request that we disclose to you what personal information we collect, use, disclose and sell about you, and the right to request deletion of personal information we collect or maintain about you. If you would like to exercise any of these rights, please mail your written request to Finpeak at the physical address below and title your request as follows or in a similar manner: "CCPA – California Resident Request". You also have the right to opt out of the sale of your personal information (as defined by applicable law), which you may exercise by clicking Do Not Sell My Info, and to not be treated in a discriminatory manner for having exercised your rights regarding your privacy rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA).

Section 6. Protecting Your Information

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer technology. In addition, we implement a variety

of security measures for you when you enter, submit, or access your information. Your payment transactions are processed through a gateway provider and are not stored or processed on our servers.

Section 7. Use of Cookies

We use cookies, which deposit small data files stored on your computer or mobile device. We use cookies to distinguish you, identify your interests and your account and its status and settings, to collect usage data, keep track of your preferences and deliver content specific to your interests. Our advertising partners may use cookies and similar technologies to identify and deliver content and advertising specific to your interests, to track the effectiveness of such advertising and to provide and analyse their services. By using our Services you consent to our, and our advertising partners' use of cookies and related technologies, and the sharing of data with our advertising partners. You can withdraw your consent to our use of cookies using your browser settings or your device's limit ad tracking settings. You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent. You can do this through your browser. Section 8. Third Party Disclosure

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information unless we provide you with advance notice. In the event of an insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership, information may also be transferred as a business asset. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others' rights, property, or safety.

However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.
