The World Bank's support to the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) is focused on developing the digital economy of FSM and supporting the government to scale up transport links, renewable energy, improve skills and employability, and strengthen public financial management.



Digital Development



Through the Pacific Regional Connectivity Program, FSM is being connected to faster, cheaper and more reliable internet. World Bank support is helping to connect FSM islands to broadband, establish the foundations for digital government services, and strengthen the regulatory environment for the digital economy. In addition, the Digital Federated States of Micronesia Project will connect outer islands to basic broadband services, establish the foundations for digital government services, and strengthen the regulatory environment to help FSM's digital economy thrive.

Transport



The World Bank's largest investments in the future of FSM are in the transport sector. In and around the water, the FSM Maritime Investment Project is improving the safety, efficiency and climate resilience of maritime infrastructure and operations across the country. On land, the FSM Prioritized Road Investment and Management Enhancement Project is helping to make the country's primary road network more resilient to the impacts of climate change, while a complimentary climate-focused road enhancement project is improving secondary roads across the country.

Jobs & Social Protection



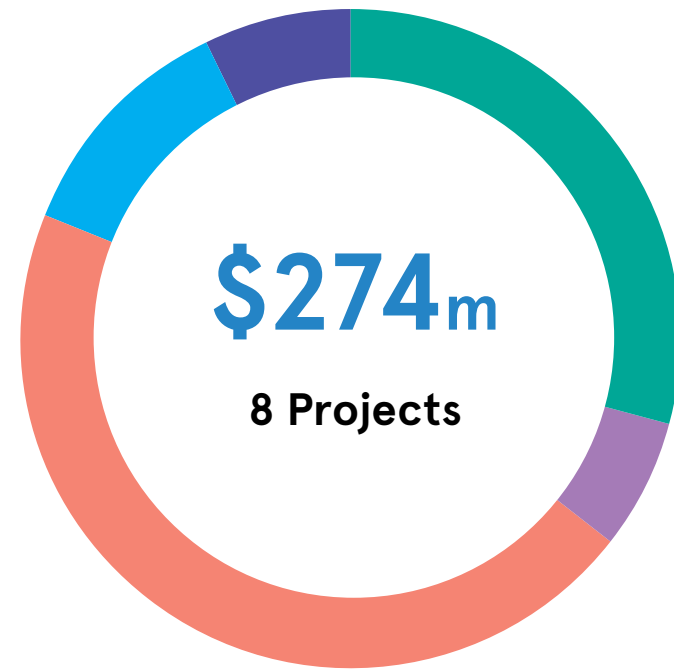
The US\$17.7 million Skills and Employability Enhancement Project, known as *FSM Skills*, is working to address a lack of access to technical and vocational training, and improve the employability and opportunities for job-seeking Micronesians, including through the establishment of a new national institution, the FSM Skills Academy. The project includes direct financial support to students for living allowances and relocation costs, grants to vocational institutions, and information campaigns on education opportunities for outer-island and low-income families.

Energy



Through the Sustainable Energy Development & Access Project, the World Bank is supporting the FSM government to improve the reliability of electricity supply, expand access to electricity, and scale up renewable energy generation.
