

Fiji

The World Bank's support to Fiji is focused on strengthening economic and climate resilience, building social protection and health systems, as well as improving infrastructure in the country.

Jobs & Social Protection



The World Bank has supported the Fiji government's COVID-19 relief measures, including cash assistance through the Fiji National Provident Fund and work to strengthen Fiji's social protection system. This support has also helped create opportunities through *Jobs 4 Nature 2.0*, a cash-for-work initiative driving environmental restoration, that has benefited close to 4,000 Fijians since it began.

Economic Resilience



The World Bank is supporting Fiji's efforts to recover from the economic impacts of COVID-19 and multiple tropical cyclones, and to strengthen Fiji's economic, social and climate resilience to future shocks.

Transport



World Bank support includes works to improve the resilience and safety of land and maritime transport infrastructure through repairing, rehabilitating, reconstructing, or upgrading selected roads, bridges, and rural jetties. It also prioritizes investments in transport infrastructure through the *Fiji Tourism Development Program in Vanua Levu* to attract more visitors and to drive community-based tourism and private sector development.

Health



In response to the global COVID-19 pandemic, the World Bank supported Fiji's efforts to improve access to primary health care and strengthen Fiji's health system to respond to public health emergencies. This includes improving connectivity for 35 health facilities across the country and supporting health infrastructure for the main hospital in Suva.

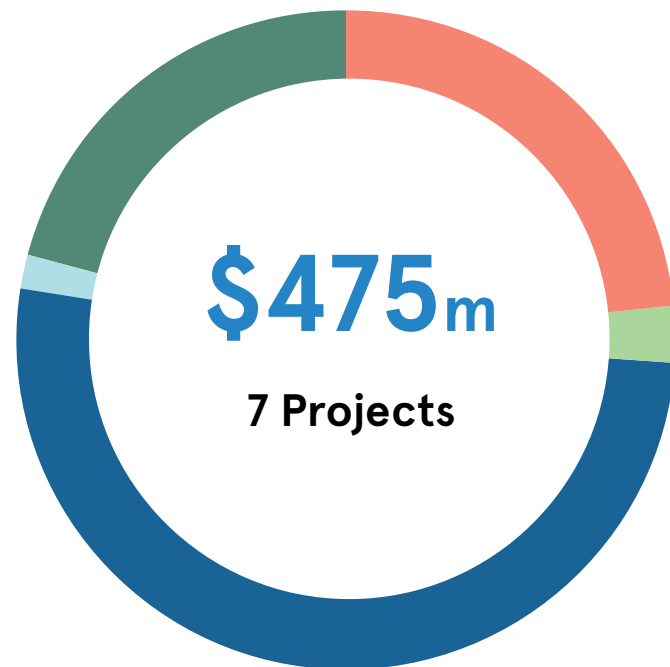
Environment & Natural Resources



In addition to backing Fiji's expansion of its marine protected areas, the World Bank has supported Fiji to strengthen its disaster resilience and address climate change, including through the *Fiji Carbon Fund Emissions Reduction Program*, which contributes to Fiji's forestry sector, reducing carbon emissions and strengthen community resilience.
