2. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

2.1 Main items discussed at last CCC meeting

2.1.1 Exchange of views with Mr Verhofstadt on the state of play on Brexit

Mr Verhofstadt outlined the latest developments and main procedural steps in the Brexit negotiations. He informed that, after the plenary resolution adopted on 5 April, a number of more specific resolutions would be adopted after the summer break and in early 2018.

Following a question from the Chair, Mr Verhofstadt committed to raise with the 27 Member States the issue of a rapid decision on the relocation of EMA.

2.1.2 Exchange of views with FVP Timmermans

The discussion focused in particular on the implementation of the 2017 Commission Work Programme and the Joint Declaration.

2.1.3 TRAN possible request for a joint delegation to IMO/MEPC 71

In relation to this likely request from TRAN, on which the Chair had consulted coordinators in written procedure, in the end the TRAN Chair decided to drop the request.
