



**Mika Leandro** is the Campaigns Director and a founding team member at WeMove.EU, a movement campaigning for a better Europe; for a European Union committed to social and economic justice, environmental sustainability and citizen-led democracy. She is the primary representative of the citizens' committee for the Stop Glyphosate ECI. She previously led a campaign team in a global anti-slavery NGO, campaigned to protect the environment and for human rights.



**Franziska Achterberg** is the EU Food Policy Director at Greenpeace. She is an expert on EU pesticide policies, including glyphosate, and represents Greenpeace in meetings with the Commission, MEPs and national governments. Since 2001 he has worked for the environmental NGO GLOBAL 2000 (Friends of the Earth Austria). He is one of seven initiators of the European Citizens' Initiative "Stop Glyphosate".



**Angeliki Lysimachou** represents Pesticides Action Network (PAN) Europe, a global network organisation that aims to replace the use of harmful pesticides with ecologically friendly alternatives. Angeliki is an environmental scientist/toxicologist with a PhD and research experience on the effects of pollutants upon environmental ecosystems. In PAN Europe, due to her scientific background, she works on pesticide toxicity issues and runs the campaigns on endocrine disrupting pesticides and glyphosate.

He is cofounder and executive director of the campaign organisation Campact, which reaches 1.9 Million people in Germany.
