## 1. Device and browser

#### Use the correct browser for your device:

## **EP hybrid**

and Edge Chromium browser



## **Any laptop/computer**

(including Macs)

and Google Chrome browser



#### **iPad** (updated to latest iOS)

and Safari browser



#### **Phone**



**Phone** connections are not allowed

## 2. Getting ready

## Microphone



For appropriate sound quality for broadcast and interpretation, please use one of the following:

- a unidirectional tabletop microphone
- a lapel microphone


## Bluetooth devices can cause additional interference and should not be used.

## **Image and surroundings**



Please make sure that you are:


- in the centre of the image
- in a well-lit location
- in a quiet room without any background noise (close windows and doors)



## 3. The meeting


#### **Allow access**

When joining the meeting, make sure you allow access to your microphone and camera.



## Language


Select your language in the Audio Channel Selector at the top-centre part of the interface where it says "FLOOR":






#### **Speak**

When given the floor, please press the SPEAK button at the bottom of the interface:



You are **on air** when the line on the button is **red**:






Please try to avoid reading out a written speech. Reading out is much faster and less interactive than speaking spontaneously.
