### **2. FORTHCOMING COMMISSION DECISION ON WORK PROGRAMME 2015**

A. **Immediate actions of general nature if any proposal is in the list of proposals to be withdrawn/modified**

**Decision taken:**      ***Coordinators decided to:***

- a) ***mandate the Chair to express in the 16 December CCC meeting the dissatisfaction of the ENVI Committee on the way in which the discussion on the Commission Work Programme was conducted;***
- b) ***invite Vice-President Timmermans to one of the ENVI January meetings to have an exchange of views with Members of the ENVI Committee in the light of his responsibility of Vice-President in charge, inter alia, of sustainable development; accordingly, the proposal of***

*Vice-President Timmermans for an exchange of views jointly with the ENVI and ITRE Committees in February 2015 was discarded;*

- c) *if either the NECs or the waste proposal or both of them are in the list of proposals to be modified/withdrawn, write to Vice-Presidents Timmermans and Katainen and Commissioner Vella to make once again clear that the ENVI committee is extremely dissatisfied with the decision;*

**B. Immediate actions if specific proposals are in the list of proposals to be withdrawn/modified**

"Circular economy and resource efficiency package"

**Decision taken:**

- a) *no action needed on the own-initiative report on "Resource efficiency: moving towards a circular economy" in case the legislative proposal is withdrawn/modified;*  
b) *the Public Hearing on waste is maintained for 22 January 2015.*

"Air quality package"

**Decision taken:** *No immediate action necessary in case one or more of the Air Quality proposals are withdrawn/modified.*

**C. Medium-term actions of general nature if any proposal is in the list of proposals to be withdrawn/modified**

**Decision taken:** *Coordinators took note of the following options - which can be combined - in view of a future discussion, if needed:*

- a) *Request authorisation to draw-up legislative initiative reports on (one or both) the withdrawn proposals; in preparation to these reports, studies can be commissioned on the added value of the proposed legislation;*  
b) *Strongly request the Commission to put forward legislative proposals replacing the withdrawn proposals in the context of the structured dialogue for the 2016 Work Programme (which will start as of March 2015);*  
c) *Follow very closely the respect of the Commission reporting obligations in the waste and air policy fields.*
