Regrets the recurrent calls by the European Central Bank (ECB) and the European Banking Authority (EBA) for the consolidation of banks in the euro area^{1a}; believes that this vision ignores substantial differences in the banking landscape across the Member States; recalls that, overall, smaller banks hold relatively few bad loans on average (nonperforming loans made up only 2.3 % of total loans at the start of the pandemic), ample liquidity buffers (the average liquidity coverage ratio was above 200 %, more than double the required minimum) and a good solvency position (with Common Equity Tier 1 capital standing at 17 %, comfortably above minimum requirements), in comparison with bigger banks; believes that further banking consolidation could potentially lead to infringements of Article 102 of the TFEU;
