24a. Recalls that reducing the production and consumption of proteins from farmed animals in the EU, particularly from animals farmed in intensive feed-based systems, would reduce the heavy dependence on plant proteins for feed; notes that more jobs could be created and a comparable level of profitability with reduced herds achieved for herbivore animal farming by switching to pasture-based grazing, allowing input costs to be cut, as well as promoting biodiversity and improving animal welfare;
