		<p><i>shall be established by the Commission by means of delegated acts adopted in accordance with Article 58 to supplement this Regulation, in consultation with Member States and after receiving the opinion of the European Food Safety Agency, by ... [six months from the date of entry into force of this Regulation], and shall consider the list of fresh fruit and vegetables laid down in part IX of Annex I to Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013. It shall take into account the risks of spoilage and food waste, when those products are sold in bulk.</i></p> <p><i>The provision shall apply only 18 months after the adoption of those delegated acts.</i></p> <p><i>In this regard the Commission should take into consideration the provisions laid down in Article 76 of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013.</i></p>
