Justification

Refill means an operation by which a container, for example a reusable glass, can be filled multiple times. You can find refill options for alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages in restaurants, cafes, airports, at global sports events etc. “Enabling refill” will make it possible for manufacturers to adjust their packaging mix in a way that is tailored to each country circumstances in order to reduce its emissions and scale reuse to establish consumer habit in all occasions. Therefore it should be possible to count refill as part of the reuse targets.
