## **European Parliament resolution on language diversity**

The European Parliament,

- having regard to 2001 as the European Year of Languages and to the fact that it is dedicated to all languages spoken in Europe,
- having regard to the Council of Europe's Charter for Regional or Minority Languages,
- having regard to several international charters that recognise the right of citizens to maintain and develop their own languages,
- having regard to the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights, which outlaws discrimination, including language-based discrimination,
- having regard to the report adopted on 16 March 2000 on the Charter of Fundamental Rights,
- A. whereas languages are part of the richness of Europe, and more than forty regional and minority languages are spoken across Europe, which form a crucial part of our cultural heritage and, as such, need to be protected and promoted,
- B. whereas the European Commission has agreed to look into the possibility of presenting a draft program that will have as its objective the promotion and safeguarding of minority and regional languages,
- C. whereas projects involving lesser-used languages have been supported during the European Year of Languages,
- D. whereas the Charter for Regional or Minority Languages constitutes a necessary part of the process of cultural preservation,
- 1. Calls for the urgent establishment of a legal basis to promote and safeguard minority and regional languages at a European level;
- 2. Calls on the European Commission to take immediate action to ensure that regional and minority languages can be promoted through the horizontal inclusion of language aspects in a variety of EU programmes;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the Commission, the Member States and the applicant countries.
