Motion for a European Parliament resolution on EU recognition of the particular characteristics of private hire vehicles with driver (PHV) and calling for better working conditions for PHV drivers

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 49 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU),
- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas PHV services play an important role in promoting alternative transport options that are reliable, safe and of sound quality;
- B. whereas PHV drivers face tough working conditions, as they have to adhere to strict rules which often differ not only from country to country but also from one municipality to the next;
- 1. Believes that the Member States need to adopt a strategic and legal approach with respect to the PHV category that would provide legal certainty, predictability, and fewer legal and administrative constraints that make the job more difficult;
- 2. Considers it imperative that the national regulatory frameworks foster fair competition among operators in the transport sector, upholding the freedoms provided for by the EU Single Market, such as freedom of establishment and free competition;
- 3. Considers it important that the national regulatory frameworks fully harness the advantages offered by digitalisation, while doing away with the extra obligations placed on the PHV category.
