The CONT Committee will hold a hearing with Commissioners Ferreira and Schmit, both responsible for the implementation of the largest part of cohesion policy. Reporting Member of the European Court of Auditors Helga Berger will represent the Court and present the main findings of the Annual Report 2023 regarding MFF Heading 2 – ‘Cohesion, resilience and values’.

In 2023, as in 2022, the rules governing the funds available for cohesion policy in the 2014-2020 programming period were made more flexible to allow the funds to be used in response to the COVID-19 crisis and as emergency support for refugees fleeing Russia’s aggression in Ukraine.

Expenditure under MFF Heading 2 amounted to EUR 73.3 billion in 2023, equivalent to 38.4 % of expenditure under the EU budget. The largest share of this expenditure came from the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) with a value of EUR 35 billion or 47.8 % of expenditure under the heading, followed by the European Social Fund (ESF) with EUR 18.9 billion or 25.8 %, and the Cohesion Fund (CF) with EUR 9.8 billion or 13 %.

The Court of Auditors has found a high error rate for the funds spent under MFF Heading 2 for 2023 – 9.3 % – which can in large part be attributed to the more flexible spending to address crises. At the same time, the Court signals that the error rate has also been pushed up by the increased implementation of the funds, with the end of the programming period 2014-2020, and the simultaneous implementation of funds under the Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF), which put additional pressure on scarce administrative resources in the Member States.

The Court has repeatedly warned that expenditure under this heading is at a high risk of errors, mainly due to the complexity of rules. Errors detected by the Court are caused by support for ineligible projects (29 % of cases, mainly related to the ERDF and CF), and reimbursement of ineligible costs (26 %, with a relatively higher share under the ESF, Youth Employment Initiative and European Aid to the Most Deprived).

The Court also points out that the audit and control system used in cohesion, with distinct responsibilities for Member State authorities and the European Commission, has vulnerabilities, since the Court continues to detect errors in projects that have been audited before by the Member States’ audit authorities, which makes it harder for the Commission to rely on the assurance given by these authorities.

The weaknesses identified by the Court have been addressed through recommendations to the Commission. The Commission has accepted these recommendations.

5. ECA SPECIAL REPORT 20/2024: COMMON AGRICULTURAL POLICY PLANS

Presentation of the special report by ECA reporting Member, Nikolaos Milionis; Exchange of views with invited Members from the Committees on Agriculture (AGRI), on Budgets (BUDG) and on the Environment, Public Health and Food Safety (ENVI)

The Common Agriculture Policy (CAP), making up to almost one third (EUR 378.5 million) of the 2021-2027 EU budget, has gone through several reforms over the years to help agriculture in the EU meet new challenges such as climate change and the sustainable use of natural resources.

The latest CAP reform was adopted on 2 December 2021 and entered into force on 1 January 2023, comprising the CAP Strategic Plan Regulation, the Horizontal Regulation on the financing, management and monitoring of the CAP and the Common Market Organisation Regulation.

The CAP reform introduced a series of general, specific and cross-cutting objectives, a new 'green architecture' based on voluntary and mandatory measures to attain those objectives, as well as a monitoring framework, based on a set of common output, result and impact indicators, to measure performance through monitoring, reporting and evaluation. To support the implementation of the CAP, each EU country drew up its own CAP Strategic Plan, which, together with their amendments, were assessed and approved by the European Commission in the second half of 2022.

In its Special Report 20/2024, the Court assessed whether the national CAP plans provide a sound basis for meeting an ambition – regarding the environmental and climate-related objectives of the 2023-2027 CAP – that is greater than in the previous period. In particular, the Court checked whether those objectives were reflected in the new 'green architecture' defined in the CAP Strategic Plan Regulation, in the Commission's assessment of the draft plans, subsequent changes to those plans and the approved plans, and in the recent EU measures taken up to April 2024 in response to farmers' requests.



The scope of the audit covered the plans of four Member States (Ireland, Spain, France and Poland), interviews with 66 farmers visited in 14 Member States as part of the ECA's 2023 statement of assurance audit, and reviews of the relevant work of the Commission and of evaluations and studies by several stakeholders (farming organisations, researchers and non-governmental environment organisations).

According to the Court, the plans actually implemented by the Member States contribute little to a further greening of the CAP and are not well aligned with the European Green Deal's goals and targets, and key elements for assessing CAP green performance are missing.

To alleviate this situation, the Court recommends that the Commission (1) promote the exchange of 'green' good practices in the strategic plans; (2) estimate the CAP contribution to the Green Deal's targets, and (3) strengthen the future (post-2027) CAP monitoring framework for the climate and the environment.

The CONT Committee will hold a hearing with Commissioners Wojciechowski and Hoekstra on the implementation of the expenditure under Heading 3 of the MFF – ‘Natural Resources and environment’, and the implementation of the Common Agriculture Policy (CAP) and EU environmental and climate policies. Reporting Member of the European Court of Auditors Klaus Heiner Lehne will represent the Court and present the main findings of the Annual Report 2023 regarding the related MFF

heading.

Expenditure under MFF Heading 3 amounted to EUR 59.5 billion in 2023, equivalent to 31.1 % of expenditure from the EU budget. The largest share of this expenditure are direct payments to farmers under the European Agricultural Guarantee Fund (EAGF), with a value of EUR 38.6 billion or 65 % of expenditure under the heading, followed by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) with EUR 16.4 billion or 27.6 %. A relatively modest amount of EUR 0.5 billion was spent through the LIFE programme for Environment and Climate. In this field, implementation of EU policy objectives is mainly pursued through mainstreaming of environmental and climate objectives in other financial instruments (such as the agricultural funds and cohesion funds) and through imposing legal obligations on Member States and society at large.

The Court of Auditors has found an error rate of 2.2 % for the expenditure under this heading, which is slightly above the materiality threshold of 2 %. The Court categorises most expenditure under this heading as ‘low risk’, since the implementation mechanism for, in particular, direct payments is very effective and characterised by a low number of errors. For the EAFRD this is different, as that fund is implemented in a way that is more error prone.

From 2023, the Commission has made (a limited number of) payments under the ‘new’, performance-based 2023-2027 CAP. Under the 2023-2027 CAP, payments are made on the basis of the achievement of objectives laid down in Strategic Plans agreed between each Member State and the Commission. Because of the limited number of performance-based payments in 2023, there is no information yet from the Court on how these payments should be seen in terms of risk of error.

7. ECA SPECIAL REPORT 13/2024: ABSORPTION OF FUNDS FROM THE RECOVERY AND RESILIENCE FACILITY

According to this ECA report, the first three years of the EU's EUR 724 billion Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF) have seen delays in funds being disbursed and projects being implemented. This put at risk the achievement of goals to help EU countries recover from the COVID-19 pandemic and make them more resilient. Even though the rate of payments from the Commission is progressing, Member States might not be able to draw down or absorb the funds in time, complete their planned measures before the RRF expires in August 2026, and thus gain the expected economic and social benefits.



Almost all countries experienced delays in submitting payment requests to the Commission, often because of inflation or supply shortages, uncertainty about environmental rules, and insufficient administrative capacity. By the end of 2023, they had submitted 70 % of their planned requests, and for around 16 % less money than expected.

On a positive note, pre-financing of up to 13 % of the amount the Member States could receive allowed more funds to be paid out quickly at the start, which was in line with the goal of responding to the crisis.

However, the Court is critical of the pace at which the bulk of the funds have been drawn down since. By the end of 2023, only EUR 213 billion had been transferred from the Commission to national coffers. These funds have not necessarily reached final recipients. In fact, almost half of the RRF funds disbursed to the 15 Member States that provided the necessary information had not yet reached final recipients.

The key event in 2023 was the revision of the 27 Recovery and Resilience Plans (RRPs) and their assessment by the Commission. Increased energy prices, high inflation and supply chain disruptions caused by Russia's unprovoked war of aggression against Ukraine, and, in some cases, natural disasters, made it challenging for Member States to implement certain reforms and investments in their RRFs.

The Commission reported that the implementation of the RRF was 'on track' as of end-2023. The revision of the plans had an impact on the pace of implementation of the existing plans. Still, implementation on the ground continued to progress throughout 2023, with the number of payment requests submitted by the end of 2023 doubling from 27 to 54 and with the achievement of most milestones and targets in line with initial expectations.

In 2023, the Commission disbursed a total of EUR 75 billion (out of which EUR 28.7 billion was in loans) and additional pre-financing payments of EUR 7.1 billion. This brought the total disbursements by the end of 2023 to EUR 220.8 billion, divided into EUR 141.6 billion in grants (40 % of the total EUR 357 billion for grants under the RRF envelope) and EUR 79.2 billion in loans (27 % of the total EUR 291 billion for loans under the RRF envelope).

In 2023, the Commission also continued to bring clarifications to the way the design of the facility is interpreted through (1) a framework for assessing the satisfactory fulfilment of the milestones and targets upon conducting the assessment, published in February 2023; (2) a methodology to determine the amount to be suspended if a milestone or target is not satisfactorily fulfilled; (3) a framework for the application of the provision related to the reversal of milestones and targets under the facility; and (4) updated 'Guidance on RRFs' following the ECOFIN Council Conclusions of April 2024 on the facility's mid-term evaluation.

Based on its ex post audits on milestones and targets, the Commission found no evidence that the audited milestones and targets were not satisfactorily fulfilled.

Written questions were submitted to the Commission on the implementation of the RRF in preparation for the hearing, answers to which were received and shared with CONT Members on 7 November 2024.

The hearing of the European External Action Service is scheduled for 21 November 2024.

Not only the European Commission, but all EU institutions (including the Parliament itself) and other agencies, bodies and joint undertakings, are subject to the process of parliamentary scrutiny of the implementation of their budget. The aim is to ensure compliance with the relevant legal and regulatory framework requirements, and verify its use in accordance with the principle of sound financial management, namely with the principles of 'economy', 'efficiency' and 'effectiveness'.

The EU institutions enjoy administrative autonomy in accordance with Articles 316 and 335 of the TFEU and they are individually responsible for the implementation of their budgets in accordance with Article 59 of the Financial Regulation. The Parliament's Budgetary Control Committee takes a decision on discharge to the other institutions and bodies on the basis of Rule 102 of Parliament's Rules of Procedure. In addition, Article 269 of the Financial Regulation provides that the legal bases for the Commission's discharge apply to EEAS mutatis mutandis.



For the discharge 2023, like in previous years, the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO) is integrated into the discharge procedure for the other institutions. The budgetary discharge is granted to the EPPO Administrative Director in accordance with Article 94(10) of the Council Regulation implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the EPPO.

The discharge hearing is based on the questions related to the 2023 discharge that were proposed by CONT Members and sent to

the respective institutions by the Rapporteur on 20 September 2023. The Q&A catalogue was forwarded to CONT Members on 7 October.

The questionnaires are focused on performance, internal controls, accountability and ethics, human resources and working conditions, resources and procurement. Moreover, attention continues to be paid to digitalisation and environmental sustainability.

The budget of all nine other institutions represented 20.39% of the MFF's Heading 7 – 'European Public Administration' for 2023 (which amounted to EUR 12.3 billion). The reporting ECA Member, Jan Gregor, will inform the Committee about the Court's findings on a budget that is mostly administrative and, as was the case for the previous discharge year, estimated at low risk.
