Written declaration on Israel's withdrawal from Gaza

The European Parliament,

- having regard to UN Security Council Resolutions 242, 338, 425, 1373 and 1397,
- having regard to the results of the Palestinian presidential election,
- having regard to the Euro-Mediterranean Association Agreement between the European Communities and their Member States and the State of Israel,
- having regard to the Quartet's 'Roadmap for Peace' of 30 April 2003,
- having regard to its previous resolutions on the situation in the Middle East and in particular that of the 23 October 2003,
- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. acknowledging the significance of Israel's withdrawal from the Gaza strip,
- B. praising Israel for the peaceful and rapid withdrawal and the commitment this demonstrates by Israel to achieving lasting peace,
- C. recognising the right of both Israelis and Palestinians to live peacefully within secure and recognised borders,
- 1. Calls on the international community to help create social and economic stability in Gaza and assist the Palestinian Authority in establishing the rule of law and security for its inhabitants;
- 2. Calls on the Arab League and the Organisation of the Islamic Conference to recognise the withdrawal as a confidence-building measure by Israel;
- 3. Calls on the European Union and national governments to help the two parties work towards a two-state solution in the region and the two sides to re-engage with the Roadmap for Peace facilitated by the Quartet;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the Council, the Commission and relevant governments.
