## Written declaration, under Rule 123 of Parliament's Rules of Procedure, on the proclamation of the European Day of Mayors<sup>1</sup>

- 1. Mayors represent the public authority closest to citizens and their everyday needs and concerns.
- 2. Protocol No 2 to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union lays down the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality, according to which wide consultations involving, where appropriate, regional and local authorities, are considered necessary.
- 3. Member States and EU institutions and bodies, including the Committee of the Regions, as representative of local and regional authorities at EU level, organise various activities to celebrate local governance, which is a component of the subsidiarity principle shared by all Europeans.
- 4. These activities promote mutual communication between mayors and EU institutions, as well as comprehension of each other's tasks and competences.
- 5. The Commission is hence called on to promote these activities and link them with the European Week of Regions and Cities, and to support the proclamation of a European Day of Mayors.
- 6. This declaration, together with the names of the signatories, is forwarded to the Commission.
