Subject: Attacks on Bangladesh's Hindu minority

On 5 August 2024, the Prime Minister of Bangladesh, Sheikh Hasina, was ousted after protesters stormed the parliament and government palace. China, the United States and the European Union<sup>1</sup> welcomed the interim government, led by Muhammad Yunus.

Jamaat-e-Islami, the main Islamist party, strongly supported the uprising. The terrorist organisation Al-Qaida in the Indian Sub-continent (AQIS) describes it as a 'significant victory for Islamists and jihadists in the region'<sup>2</sup>. On 27 August, the interim government ordered the release of Jasimuddin Rahmani, who leads a terrorist group linked to Al-Qaeda<sup>3</sup>.

Since then, the Hindu minority, making up 8 % of the population, has been targeted by suspected Islamist groups. Many of their temples, shops and houses have been burned down<sup>4</sup>.

- 1. Is the Commission worried about Bangladesh becoming a safe haven for armed Islamism, jeopardising regional security and global counter-terrorism efforts?
- 2. Will it take steps to condemn the attacks against Bangladesh's Hindu minority, and reconsider its support for the interim government?
