Question for written answer E-001927/2024 to the Commission Rule 144 Dirk Gotink (PPE)

Subject: Erasmus+ funding from the Commission for the controversial Gazientep University

According to an article¹, there is an Erasmus+ partnership between the Commission and Gaziantep University and the university recently received EUR 250 000 from the EU. The article points to a host of anti-Israeli statements and states that the university rector actively supports the Hamas terrorist organisation. Accordingly:

- 1. Is this report about the Commission providing EUR 250 000 in Erasmus+ funding for Gaziantep University true?
- 2. When establishing relations with Gaziantep University, did the Commission also look into the statements by the rector and his possible links with Hamas?
- 3. Does the Commission concur that, in view of the rector's statements, the agreement with the university should be immediately terminated? If not, why not?
