## Question for written answer E-002476/2024 to the Commission Rule 144 Per Clausen (The Left)

Subject: EU-supported human rights violations against asylum seekers

'Politico' and 'The Guardian' have documented widespread human rights abuses in connection with EU-supported efforts to deal with asylum seekers in Tunisia and Türkiye.<sup>12</sup> This includes funding for removal centres and for the Tunisian National Guard. The Commission also announced this week that it will work to establish return hubs.

- 1. In this context, will the Commission explain what is being done to verify compliance with human rights in connection with such EU-supported activities in third countries and what will be done to ensure that, in future, EU support is given only to activities where human rights are observed?
- 2. Does the Commission believe that this raises concerns as to the EU's ability to ensure compliance with human rights in return hubs that may be established in third countries?
