Subject: Georgia's law on 'transparency of foreign influence' and its compliance with EU

law and fundamental values

In the first half of this year, Georgia adopted a law on 'transparency of foreign influence', which the Vice-President of the Commission / High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy, Josep Borrell, had previously described as 'not in line with EU core norms and values'.

Interestingly, the Commission's criticism of this law has abated, or rather disappeared, since its adoption. In the light of the foregoing, is the wording of this law as adopted in line with the Commission's expectations, or does the Commission still see this law as being contrary to EU law and fundamental values?
