The fifth meeting of the European Political Community (EPC) and a subsequent informal European Council meeting took place on 7 and 8 November 2024 in Budapest, Hungary. According to media reports, the Dorothea Hotel, owned by Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orbán's son-in-law, was explicitly recommended to participants by the Hungarian presidency of the Council of the EU.

- 1. Did the Commission President and the rest of the Commission delegation stay in the recommended Dorothea Hotel while attending the EPC and European Council meetings in Budapest that week?
- 2. Were the Commission President and the services responsible for booking the accommodation aware that the recommended accommodation, the Dorothea Hotel, was owned by the Hungarian Prime Minister's son-in-law?
