Subject: Financing activities on LGBTQ+ issues with EU funds

From 1 to 10 September 2024, a seminar entitled 'DragTivism Jr.' is to be held in the Spanish city of Girona, funded from the EU's Erasmus+ programme. It will cost a total of EUR 35 730, entirely covered by the EU budget<sup>1</sup>. The event aims to engage 14-17 year olds on LGBTQ+ issues, debating with them 'fluidity' and gender, exploring their 'possible alter egos' and informing them of what drag queens do, also with a view to their 'future employability'.

## Can the Commission therefore:

- 1. Give its view on the use of public funds to finance activities of this kind?
- 2. Say which other LGBTQ+-related activities have already been considered eligible for funding, and in what amount?
- 3. State whether it considers it appropriate to involve adolescent children in activities of this nature?
