Subject: Action to support civil society organisations in Member States

Civil society organisations play a key role in protecting the rule of law and democratic values in the EU. Unfortunately, in some Member States, these organisations face a number of challenges, such as financial difficulties, political pressure and legal restrictions, which hamper their activities.

In this connection:

- 1. What steps is the Commission taking to support civil society organisations in the Member States financially and operationally?
- 2. Is the Commission planning to set up a rapid support mechanism for NGOs in crisis situations where their activities are under threat in specific Member States?
- 3. How does the Commission intend to protect NGOs from unjustified legal attacks and restrictions by national authorities?
