- 1. What steps is the Commission taking to accelerate the diversification of the EU's energy sources, in particular as regards gas, oil and coal?
- 2. Does the Commission plan to increase investment in energy infrastructure, such as LNG terminals and interconnections between Member States, to ensure security of supply?
