Subject: National implementation plans for the New Pact on Migration and Asylum

The deadline for submitting national implementation plans, 12 December 2024, has passed. The swift and effective implementation of the New Pact on Migration and Asylum by the final deadline of 12 June 2026 must remain a top priority for all Member States.

National implementation plans play a crucial role in ensuring that Member States are fully prepared for the tasks ahead. In this regard, we, the undersigned MEPs of the Renew Europe Group, have the following questions:

1. From which Member States has the Commission received a national implementation plan (a) on time; (b) belatedly; or (c) not at all (listed individually per Member State)?
2. For the Member States that have not submitted a national implementation plan, what are the reasons (listed individually per Member State)?
3. How does the Commission rate each of the national implementation plans it has received (listed individually per Member State) in terms of comprehensiveness, specificity, scope and feasibility?
